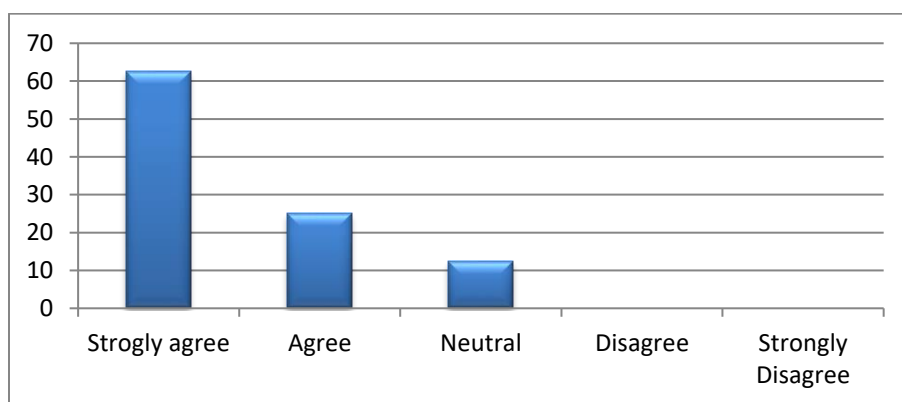

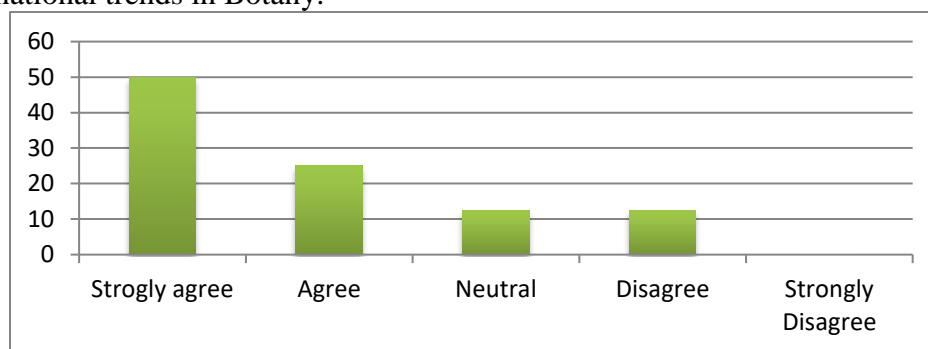
Question wise report Analysis

Question 1: The academic plan given in advance helped me to plan my academic activities



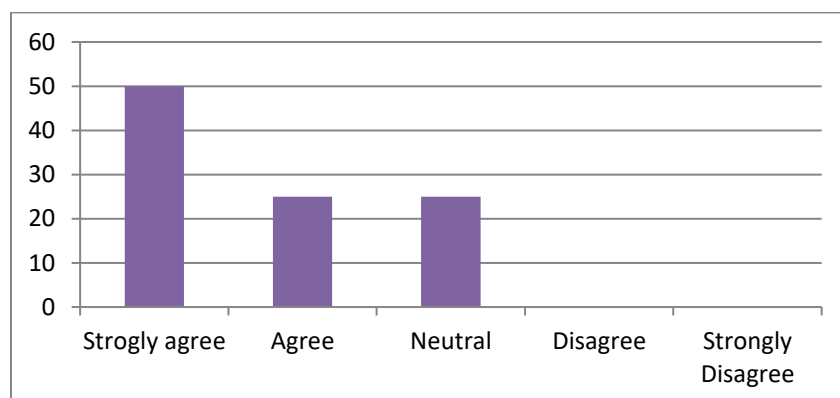

Question 2: Current Syllabus adequately covers contemporary topics /global issues/emerging global and national trends in Botany.



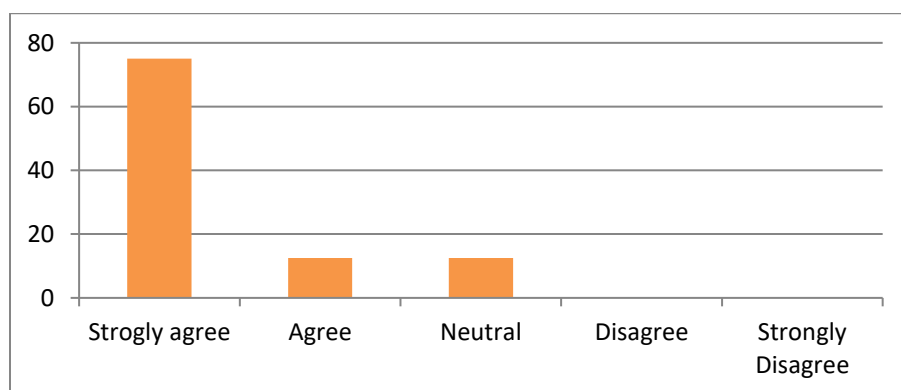

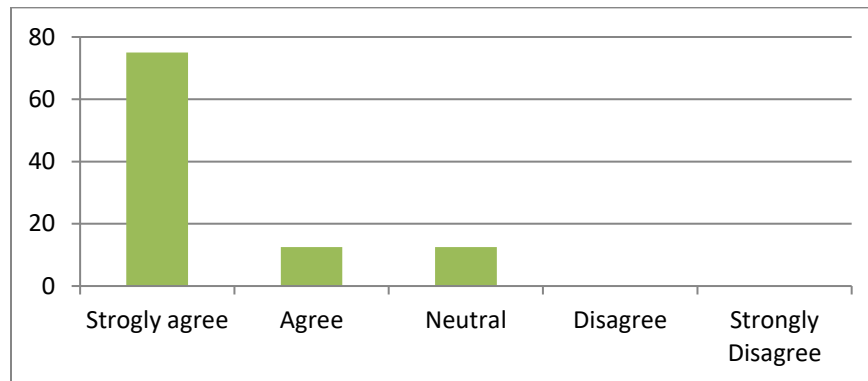

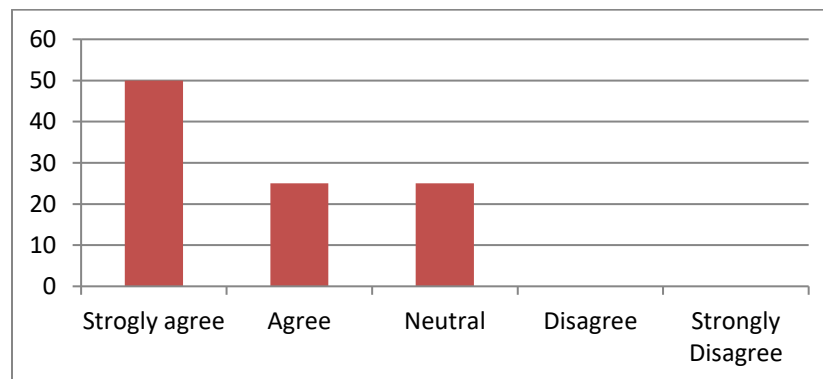

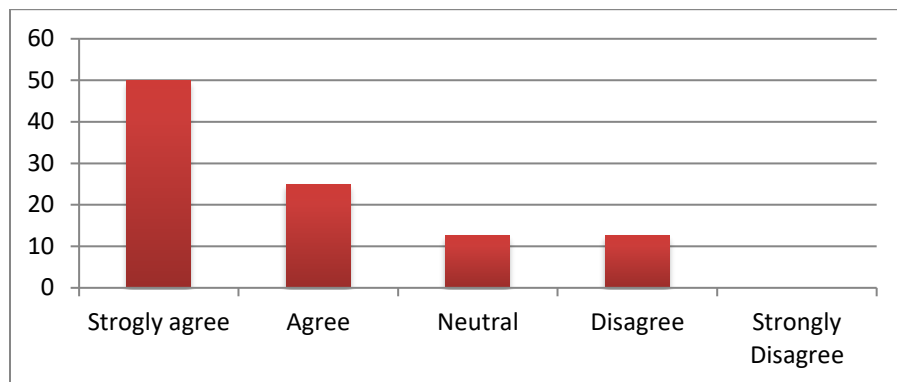

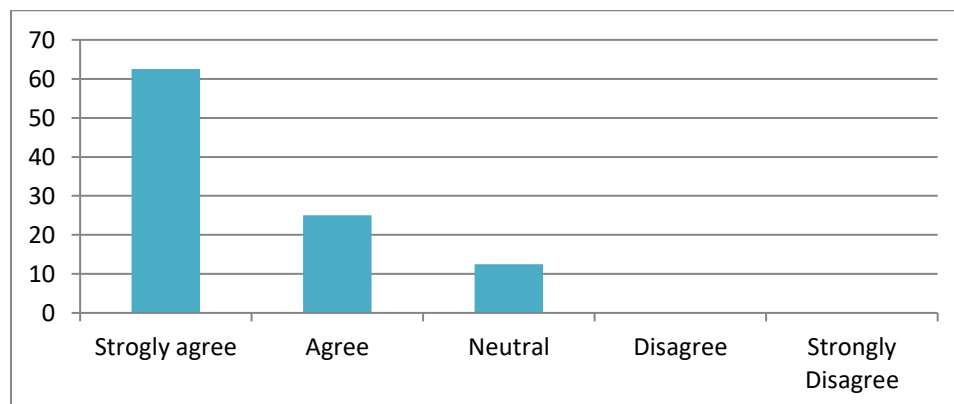

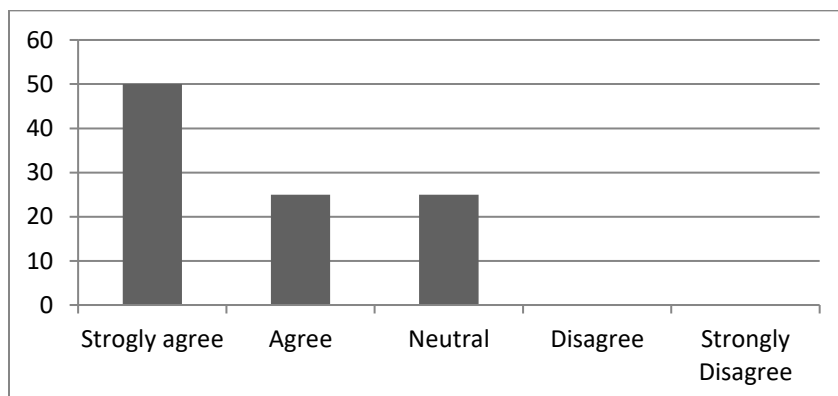

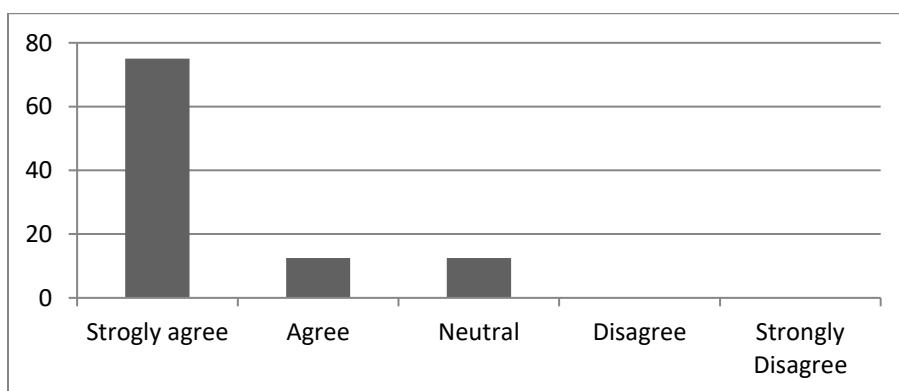

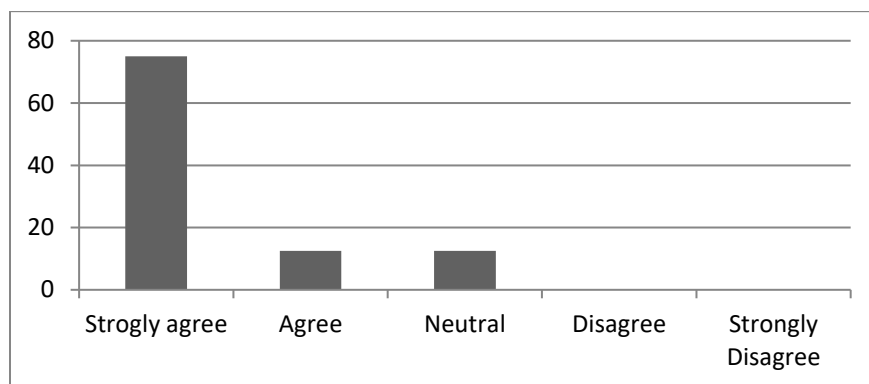

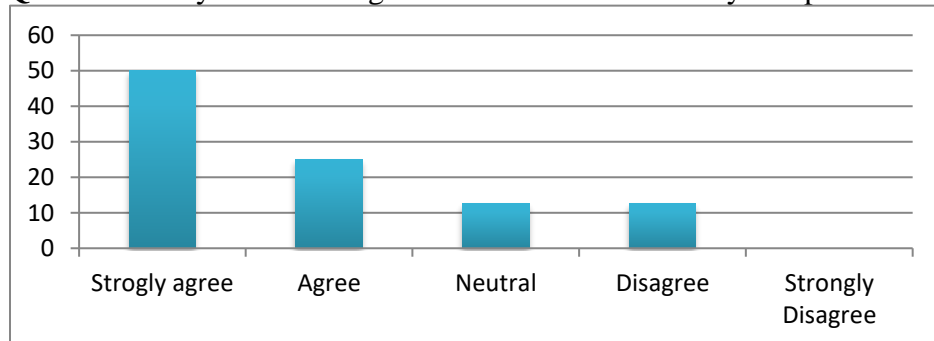

Question 1: Contents of syllabus are relevant to the course



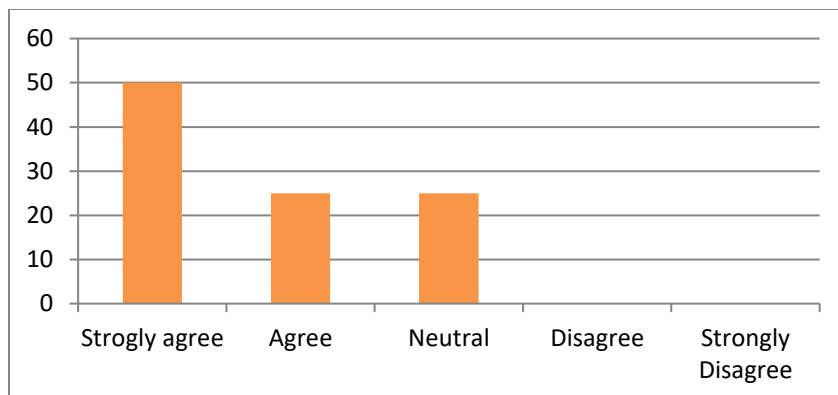

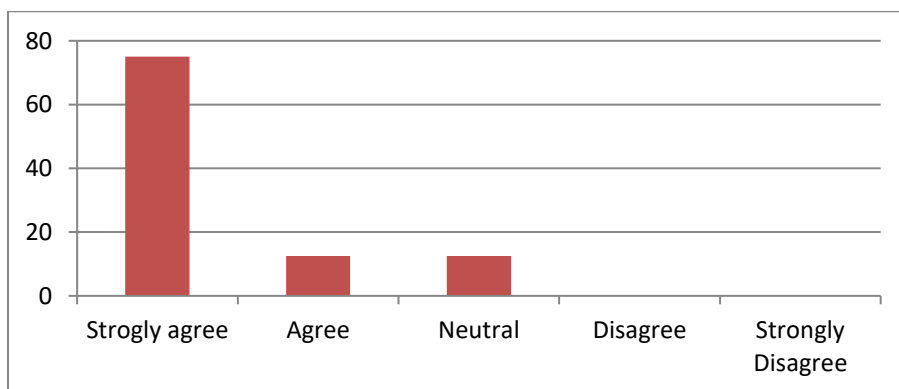

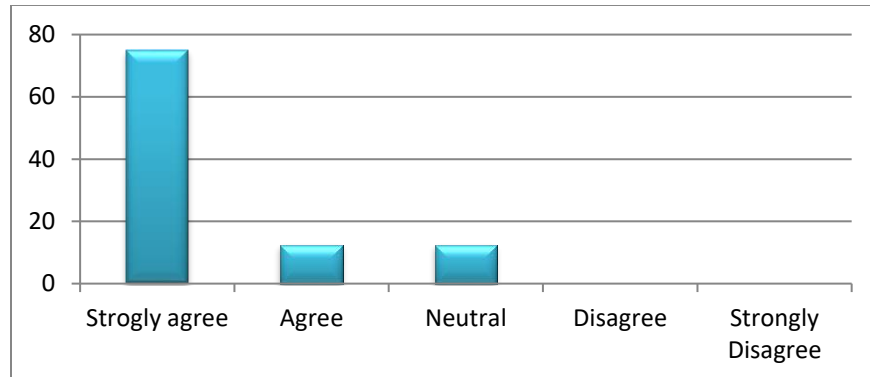

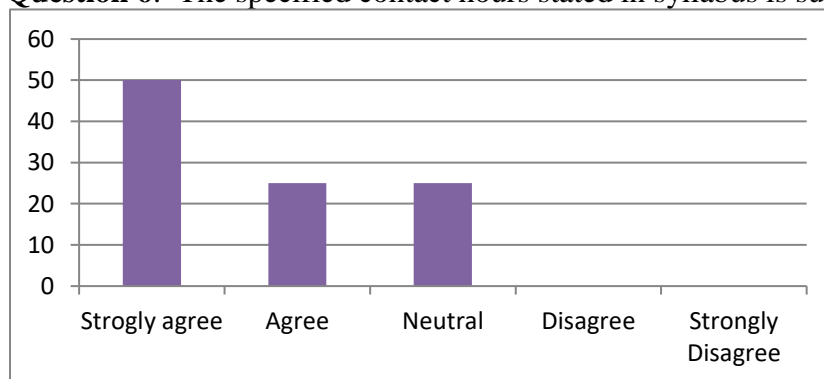

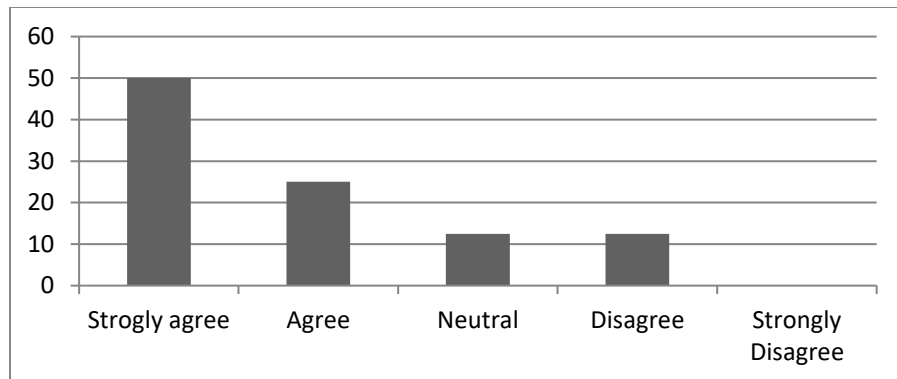

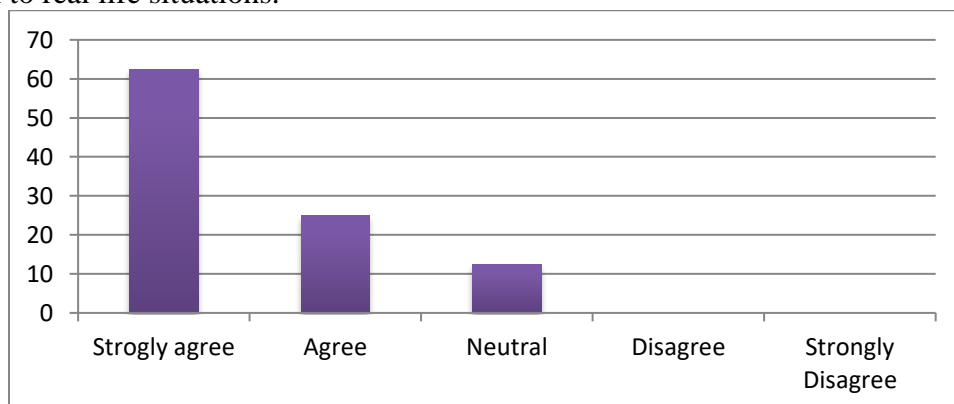
