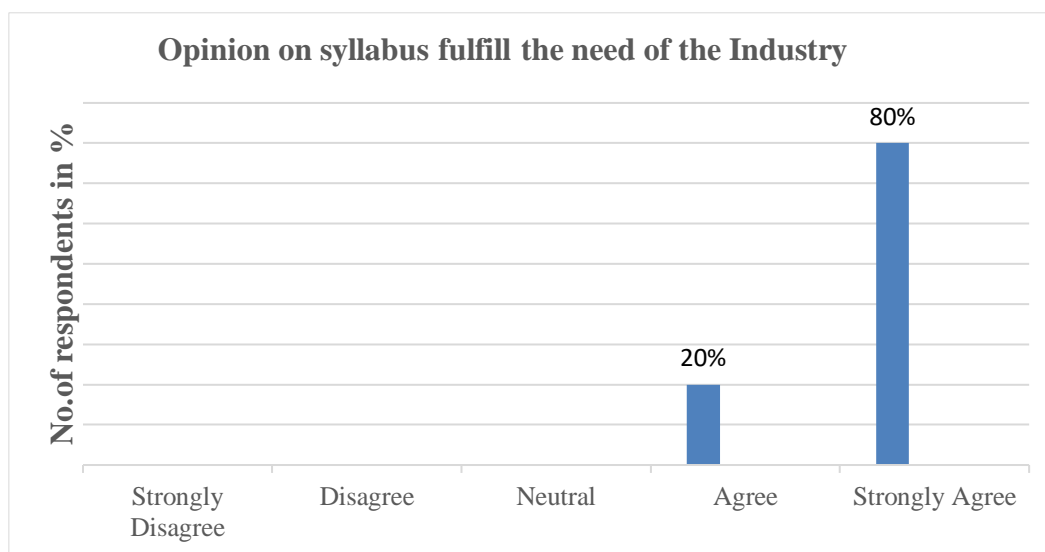

Chart 1: Opinion on syllabus fulfill the need of the Industry



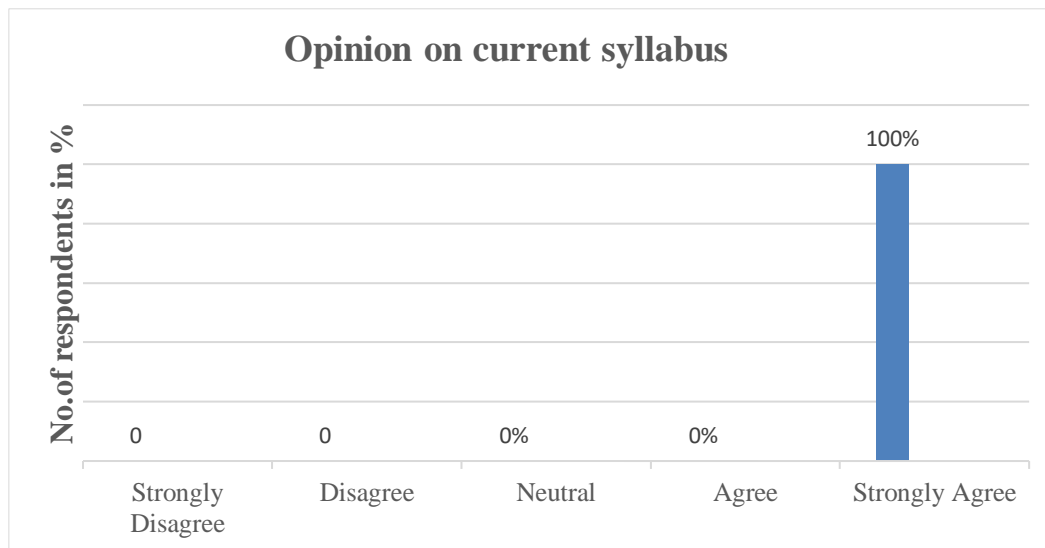

**Chart 2: Opinion on current syllabus adequately covers contemporary topics**



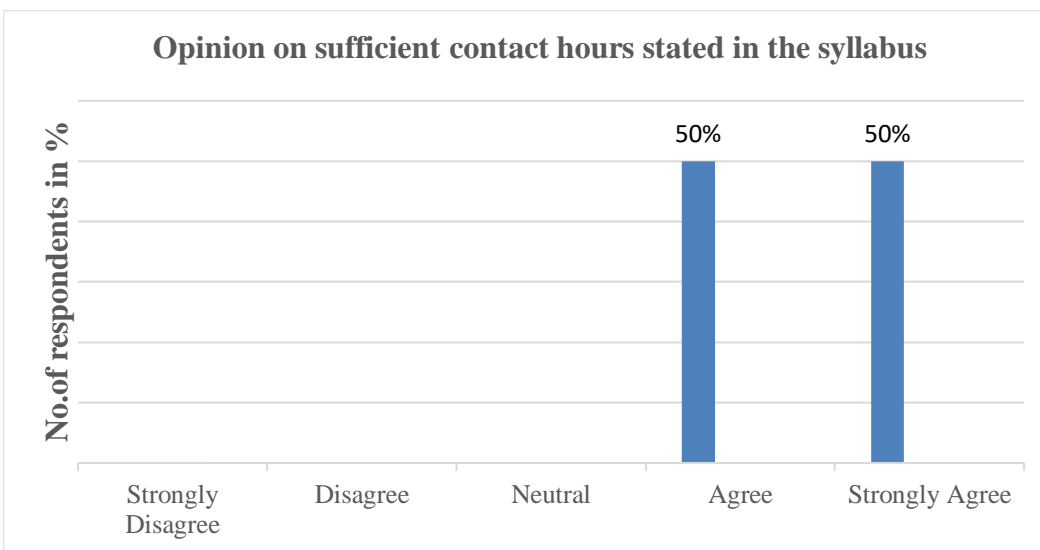

**Chart 3: Opinion on sufficient contact hours stated in the syllabus**



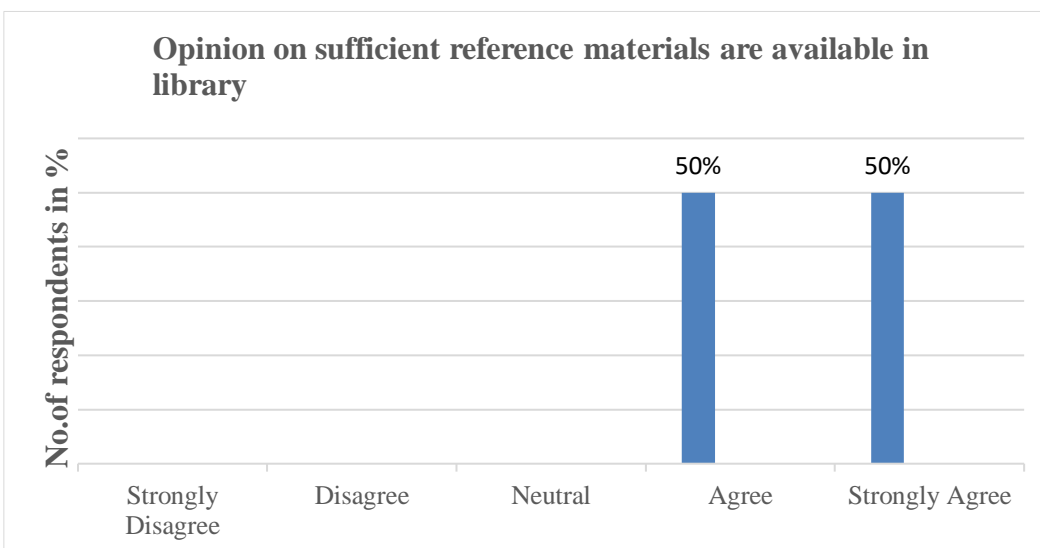

**Chart 4: Opinion on sufficient reference materials and books are available in the library**

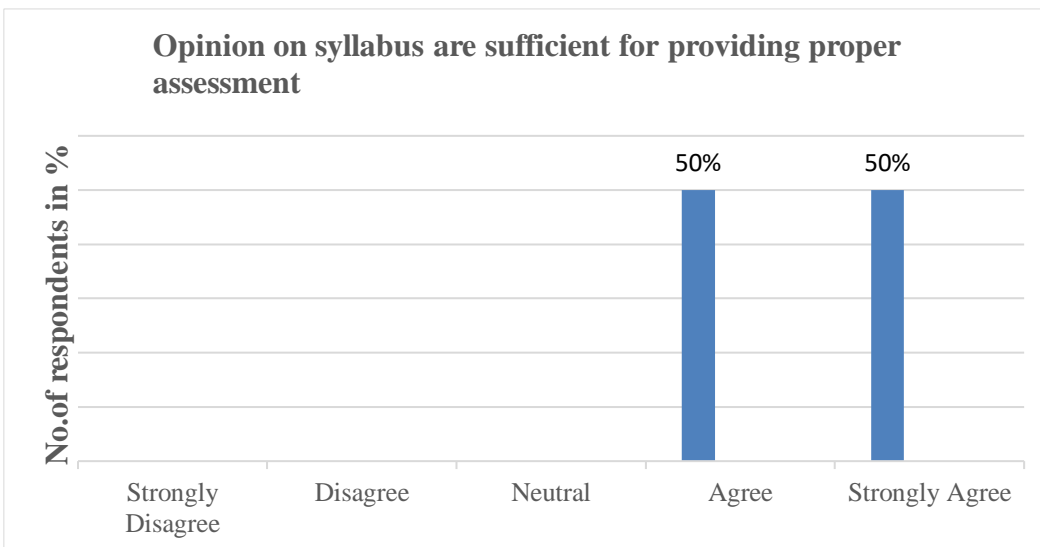

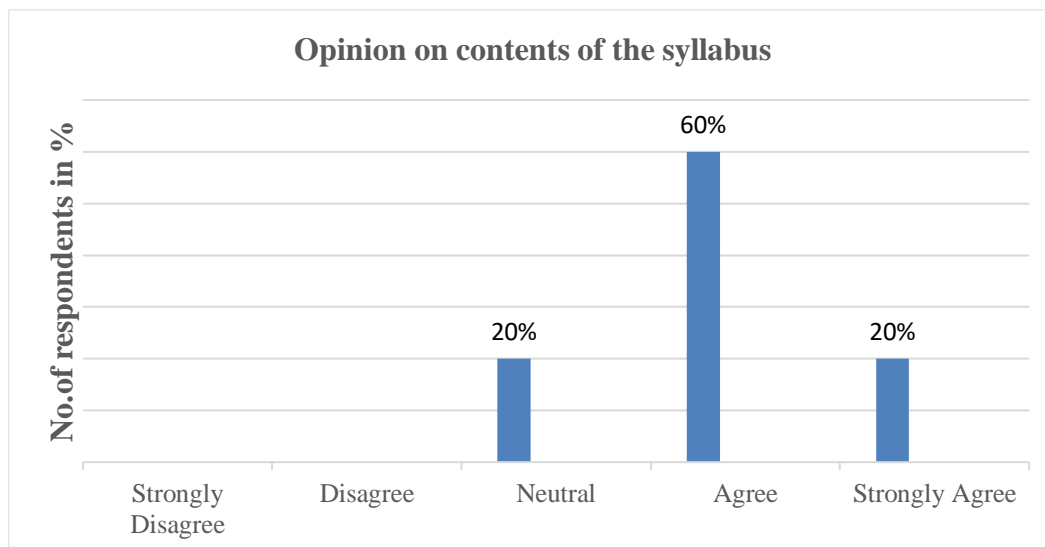
**Chart 5: Opinion on syllabus are sufficient for providing proper assessment****Interpretation:**

**Chart 6: Opinion on contents of the syllabus**



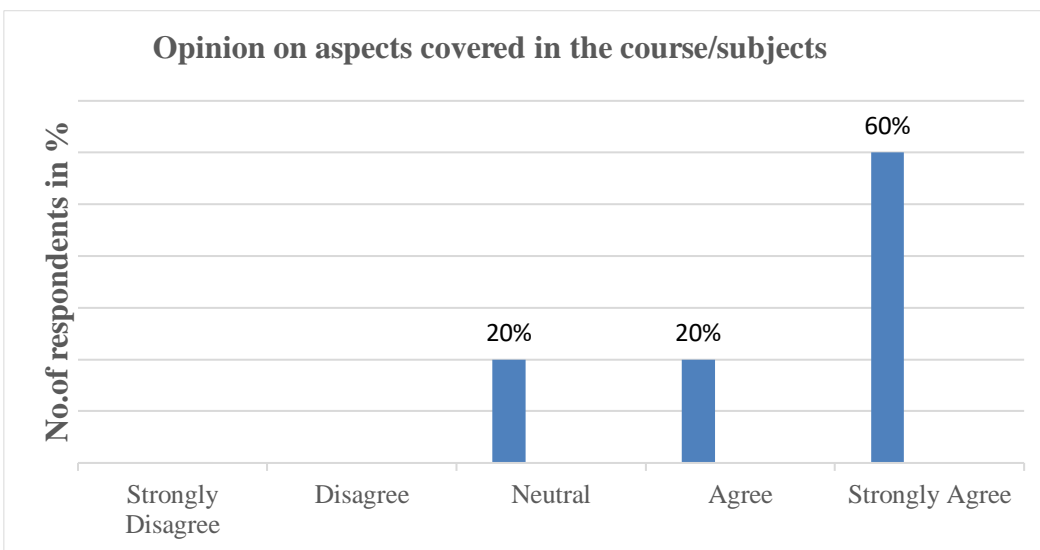

**Chart 7:Opinion on aspects covered in the course/subjects**



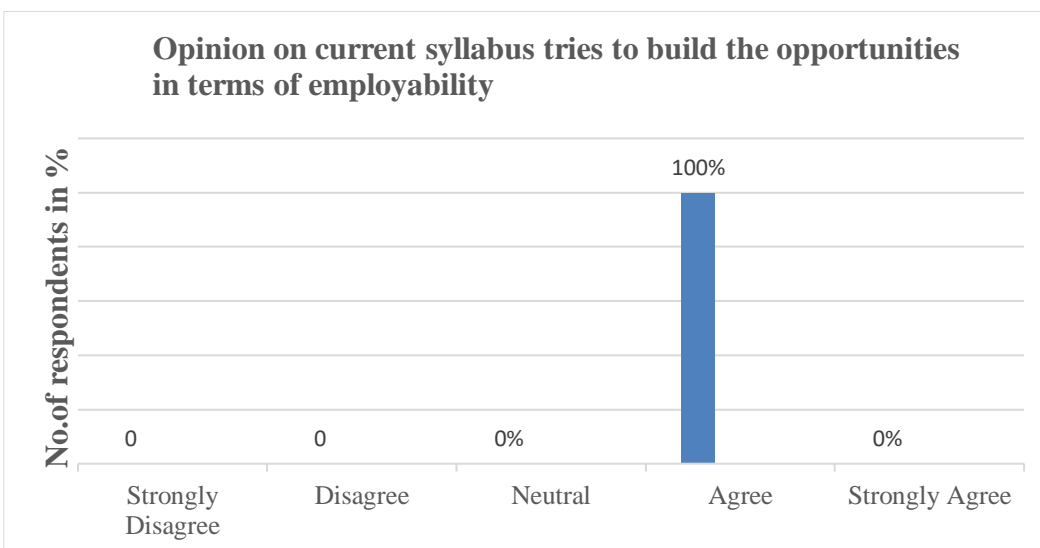

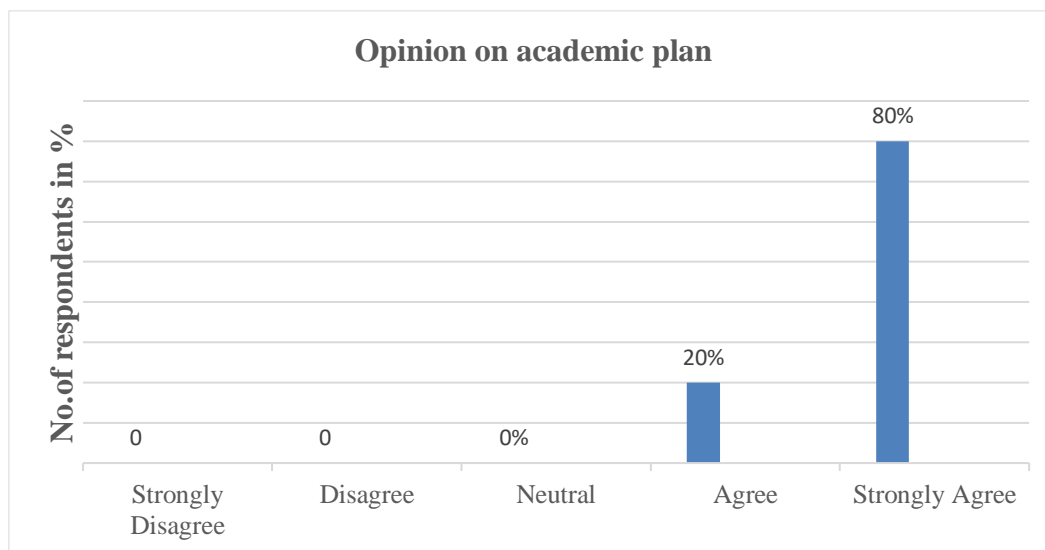

**Chart 1: Opinion on academic plan given in advance helped me to plan my academic activities**

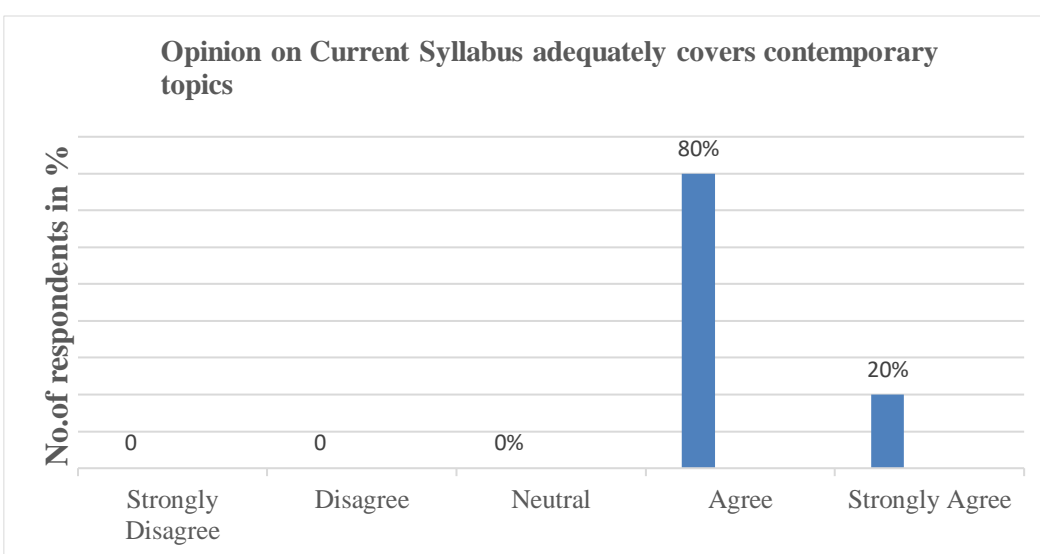

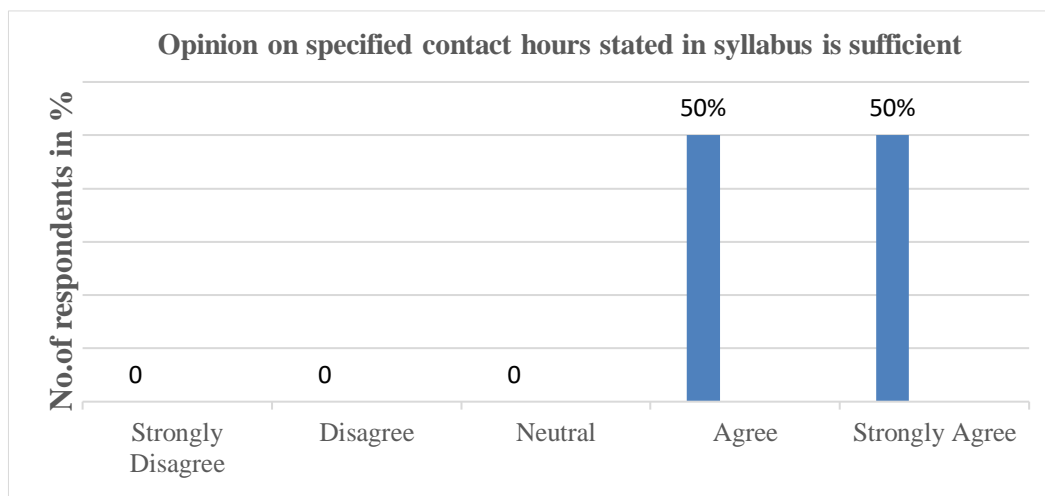
**Chart 2: Opinion on Current Syllabus adequately covers contemporary topics****Interpretation:**

**Chart 3: Opinion on specified contact hours stated in syllabus is sufficient**



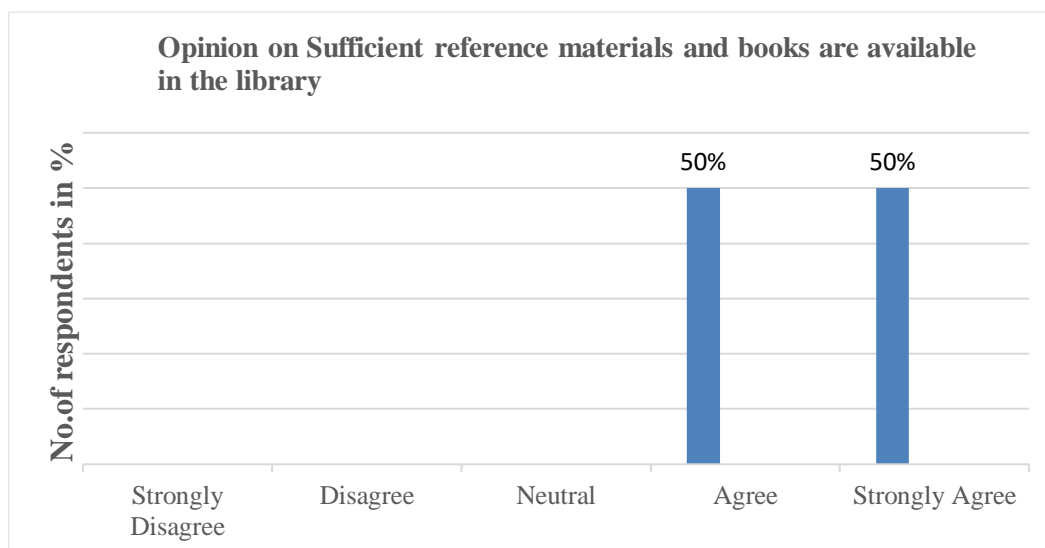

**Chart 4: Opinion on Sufficient reference materials and books are available in the library**



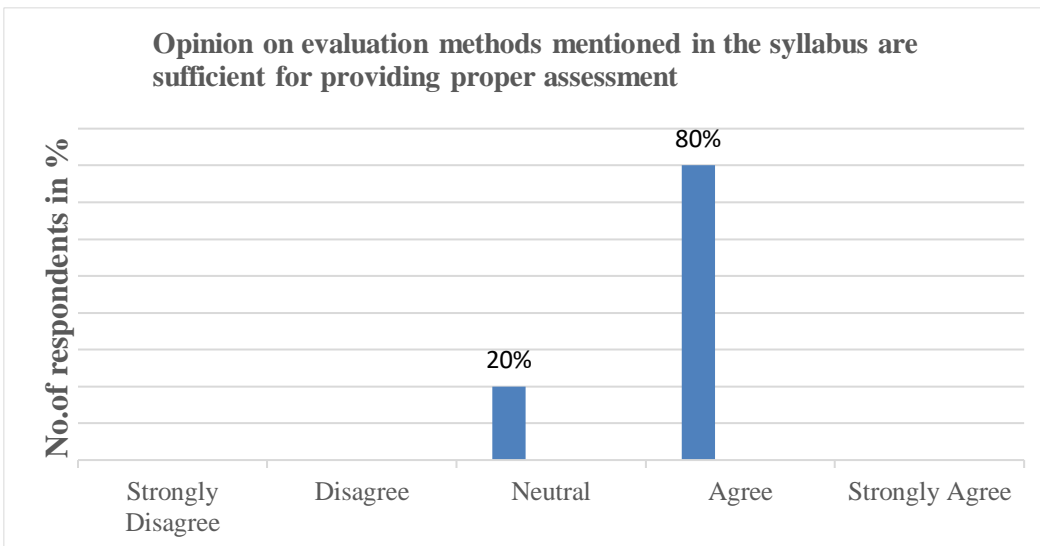

**Chart 5: Opinion on evaluation methods mentioned in the syllabus are sufficient for providing proper assessment**



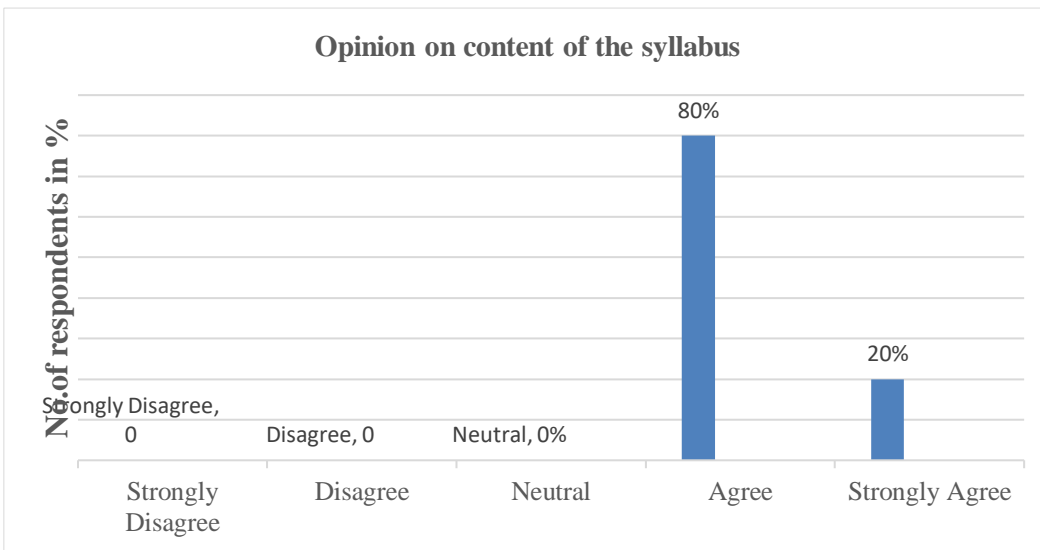

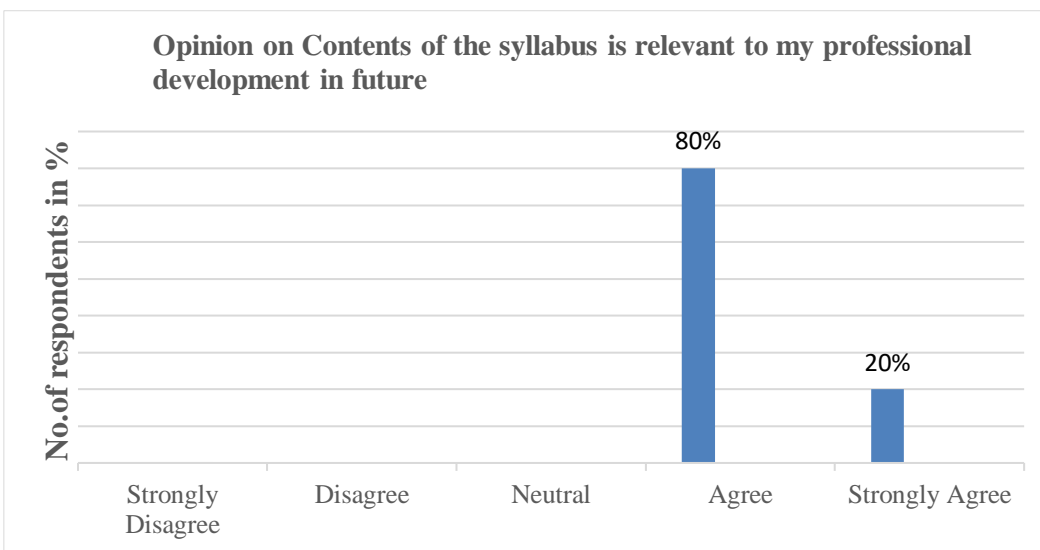
**Chart 6: Opinion on content of the syllabus****Interpretation:**

**Chart 7: Opinion on Contents of the syllabus is relevant to my professional development in future**



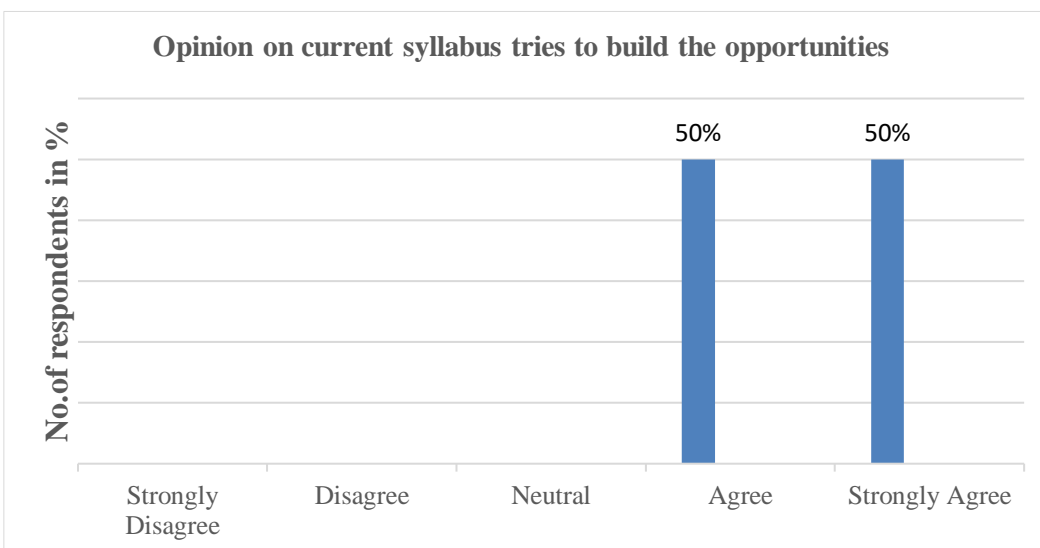

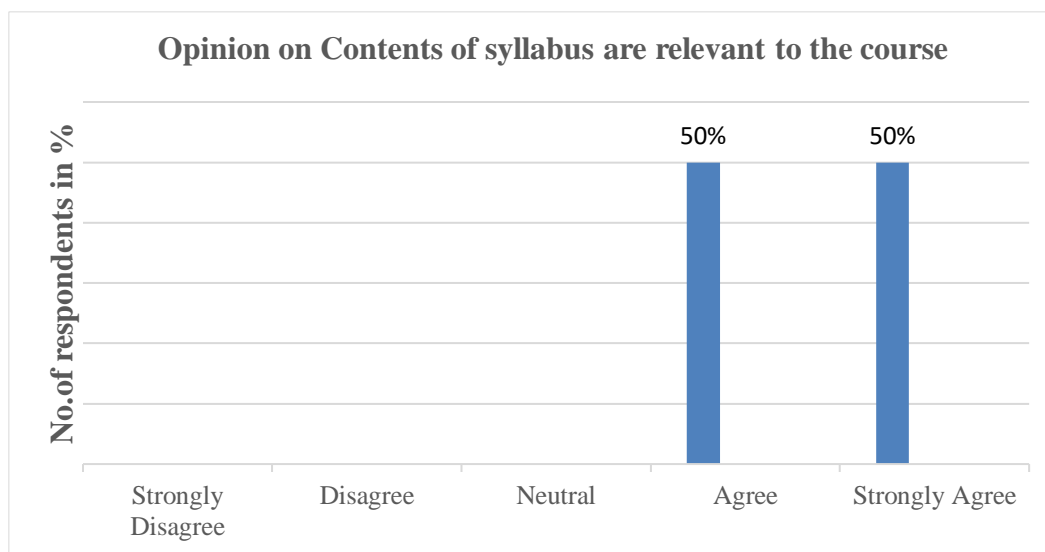

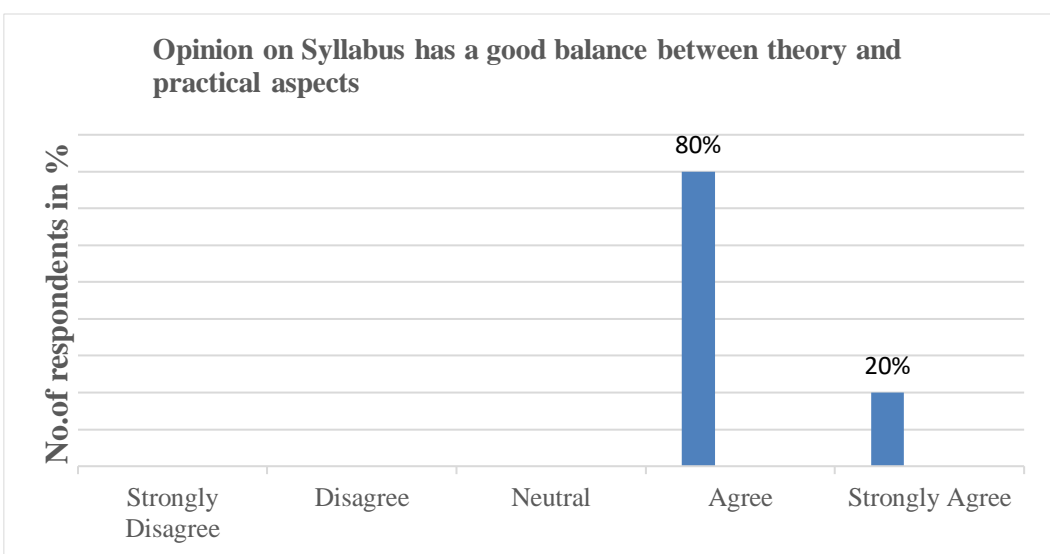

**Chart 2: Opinion on Syllabus has a good balance between theory and practical aspects**



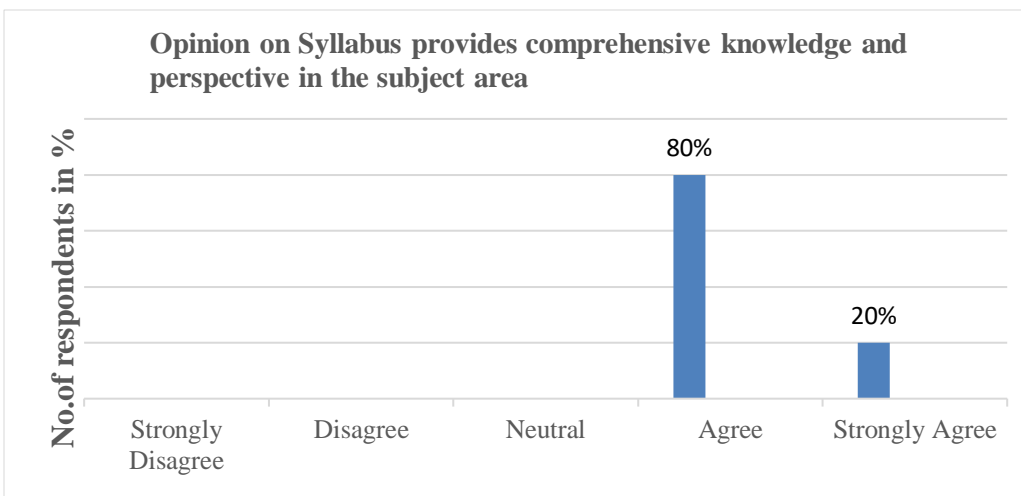

**Chart 3: Opinion on Syllabus provides comprehensive knowledge and perspective in the subject area**



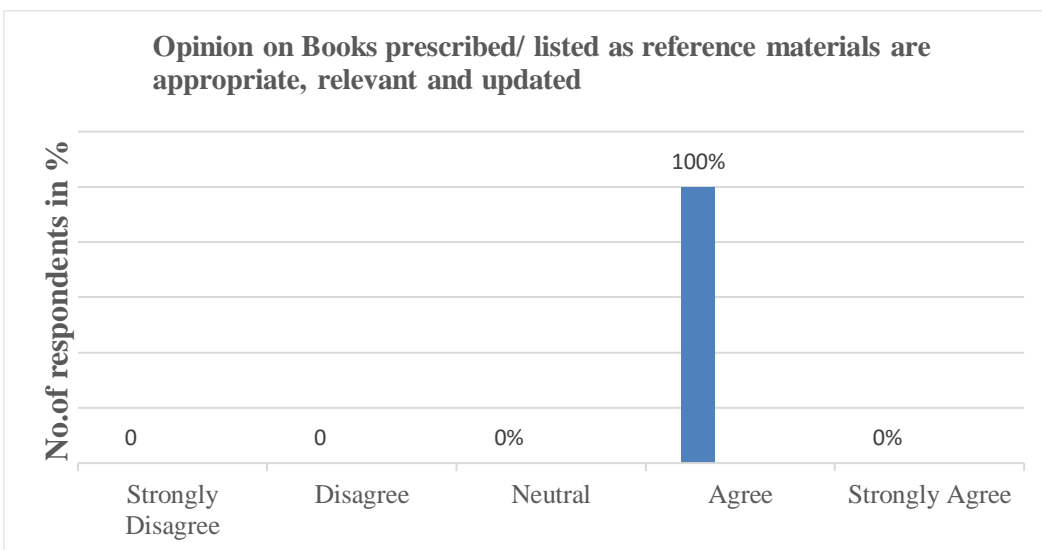

**Chart 4: Opinion on Books prescribed/ listed as reference materials are appropriate, relevant and updated**



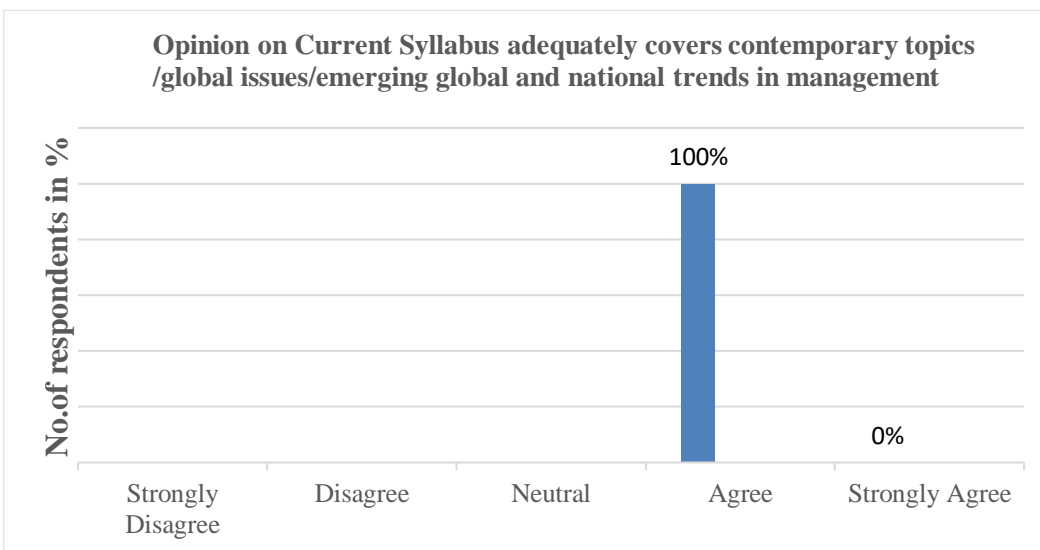

**Chart 5: Opinion on Current Syllabus adequately covers contemporary topics /global issues/emerging global and national trends in management**



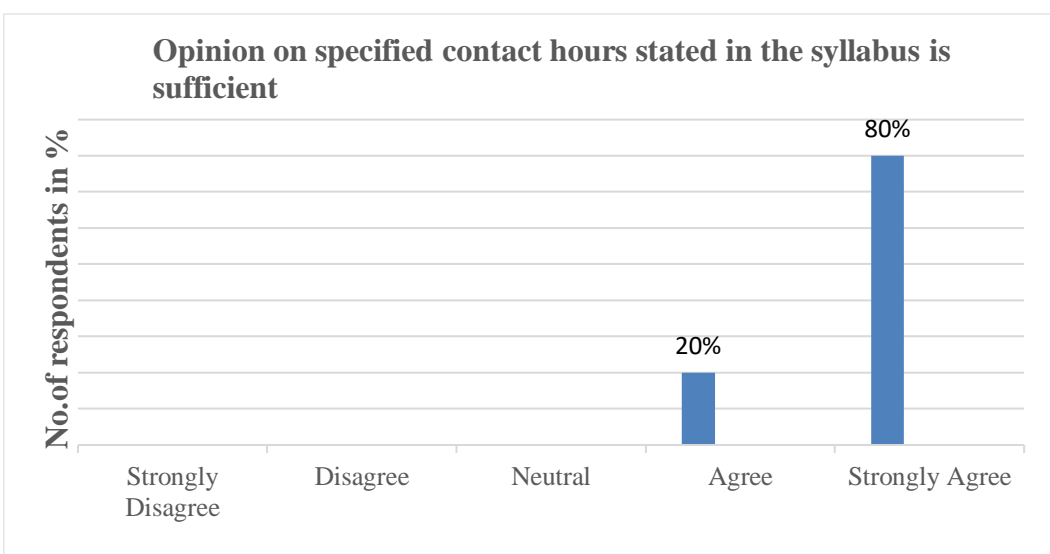

**Chart 6: Opinion on specified contact hours stated in the syllabus is sufficient**



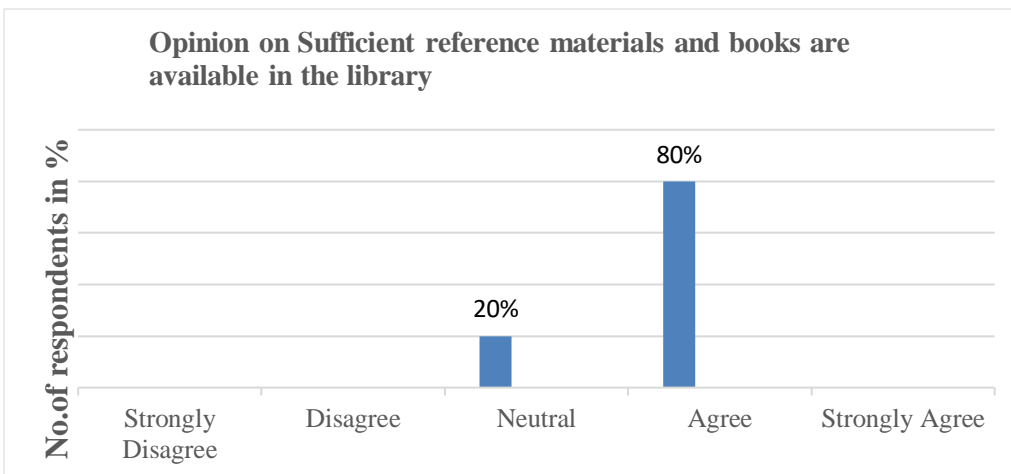

**Chart 7: Opinion on Sufficient reference materials and books are available in the library for the topics mentioned in the syllabus**



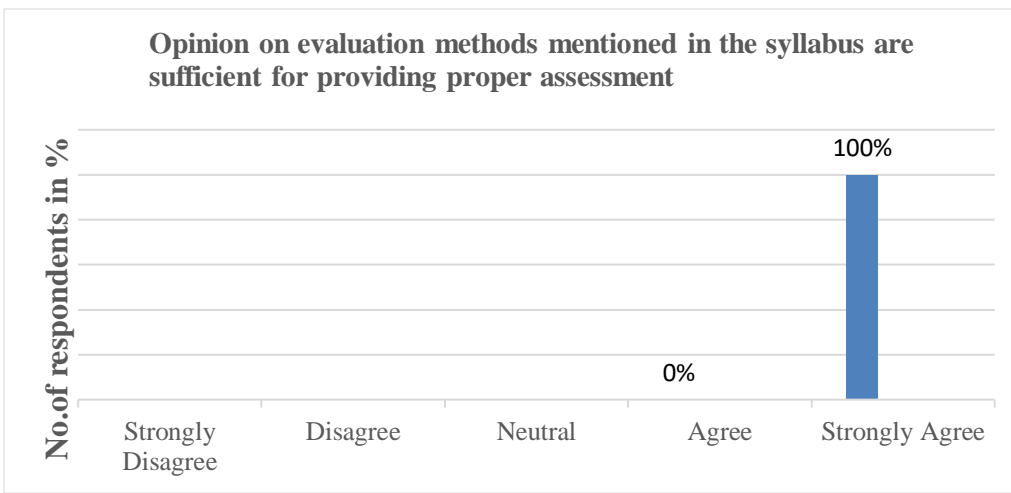

**Chart 8: Opinion on evaluation methods mentioned in the syllabus are sufficient for providing proper assessment**



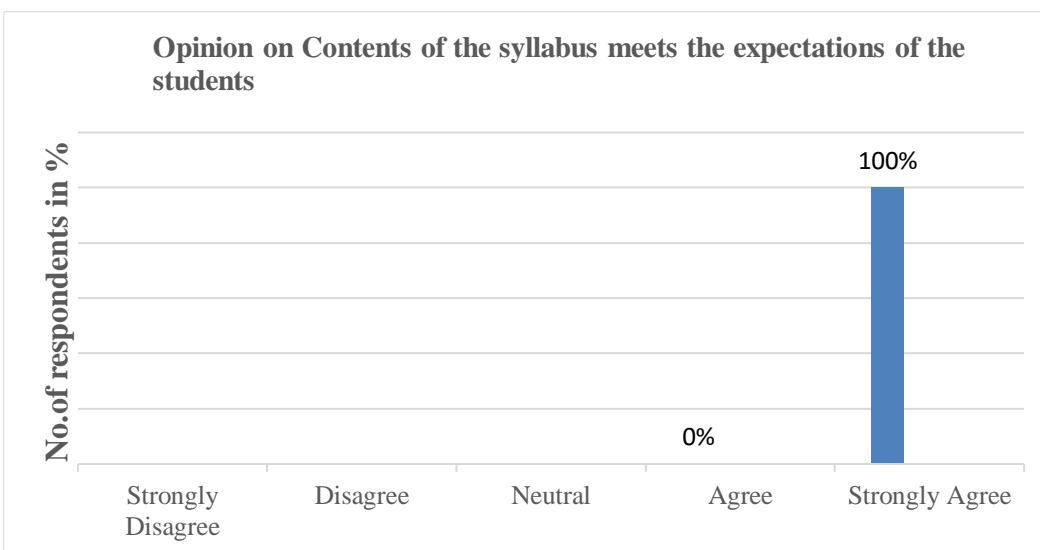


