

Chart 1:Opinionontheacademicplan



Chart2: Opiniononthecurrentsyllabus







Chart4:Opinionontheavailabilityofsufficient reference material





Chart5:Opinion ontheevaluationmethods





Chart6:Opiniononcontentsofthe syllabus





Chart7:Opinion onContentsofthe syllabus







Chart1:Opiniononthecontentsofsyllabus





Chart2:Opiniononthesyllabus





Chart3:Opiniononthesyllabus





Chart4:Opiniononthereferencematerial





Chart5:Opiniononthecurrentsyllabus





Chart6:Opiniononthespecified contact hours





Chart7:Opinionontheavailabilityofreferencematerials





Chart8:Opinionontheevaluationmethods







Chart1:Opiniononthecontentsof syllabus



Chart2: Opinion on the current syllabus



Chart3:Opiniononthespecifictimeforcoverageofsyllabus



Chart4:Opinionontheavailabilityofsufficient reference material



Chart5:Opinion ontheevaluationmethods



Chart6:Opiniononcontentsofthesyllabus



Chart7: OpiniononComputerorientedpracticals


