• Deciding the SRP topics with the consultation of the student groups.


• Conduct SRP group meetings frequently, encourage and guide the students to complete the SRPs within stipulated time.







Book Review on

Review: karnataka is one of the better developed states in India. Land reforms and other development initiatives and opportunities aimed at backward classes and dalits in the 1980s created a society that is not as polarised as in some of the other states in india. This has led to the formation of fairly cohesive society (Manor 1997). A less well known fact about karnataka relates to its long experimentation with decentralisation. Attempts to devolve powers to local bodies had been initiated even before independence. A serious effort to decentralise political structures in karnataka came about in the 1980s. The first major landmark in karnataka was the 1983 Act, which introduced a two-tier, elected sub-state level governance structure. A notable feature was 25 percent reservation for women in these bodies even before this was mandated by the Constitution. Elections under this Act were held in 1987. The 1983 Act was substituted by a new law in 1993 (karnataka panchayat Raj Act, 1993) to accommodate the mandatory provisions brought in the 73rd and 74th amendments to the Constitution. The 1993 Act provides for a three-tier stucture zilla panchayat (districts level), taluk panchayat (block level) and grama panchayat (village level).

Conclusion: The panchayati Raj in India is a system established from the time immemorial, From the above research we see that the traces of the panchayati Raj found in the Ramayana Mahabharatha period. We also see from the chanakya Arthasastra which mention about local self-government and its fuctions.
