IQAC plays significant role in quality enhancement and quality sustenance in the college. It plans strategies keeping in view of the vision and mission of the institution. Dr. Shankaranarayan K was appointed as the Co-Ordinator for the NAAC IV cycle SSR preparation.

Prof S.N Kakathkar and Dr.Vishwanath.P were they coordinators during NAAC Peer team visit to the college on 30th and 31st January 2023.

A hand book of Best Practices of the institution was prepared. Policy hand book was redrafted. PO's COs were edited.

IQAC conducted meetings on 26-08 -2022, 07-12-2022 and 30-05-2023.

Despite set back from Covid-19 and its effect college conducted various training programmes and workshops.

IQAC Initiatives

ICT was used extensively in teaching. ICT infrastructure was upgraded.

Multimedia studios were upgraded. E-lectures of the faculty recorded at the multimedia studios were uploaded to SDM multimedia you tube channel. E contents prepared by the faculty were adopted uploaded to EERPMS software so that students can access them anytime using 'Student Space' portal.

IQAC conducted an assessment of infrastructure, facilities, campus maintenance, functioning of departments and other quality initiatives by collecting feedback from students through weekly surveys conducted by Campus Audit and Appraisal Committee. Feedback was analysed and used for quality improvement/sustenance.

The suggestions and feedback about the Institution in general and about campus maintenance, facilities, library services are sought for improvement.

IQAC practices Periodic and Term End Review Mechanisms to ascertain quality in the overall outcome of the institution. The performance of the functional committees and the coordinators of the functional committees were reviewed and measures were taken for improvement.

The departments carried out the diagnostic surveys to assess the learning outcomes of the courses taught and measures were taken to address slow and advanced learners.

Term End Reviews were carried out to audit the overall performances of the institution and the results were communicated to the departments, committees and subcommittees. These initiatives provided ample opportunities for better performance based on the marks scored in semester end examinations, Institutional Education Standard Assessment Index [IESAI] was prepared and used for further action.
