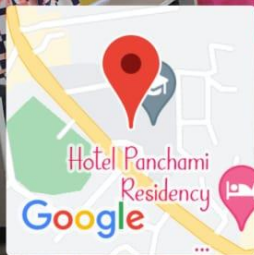

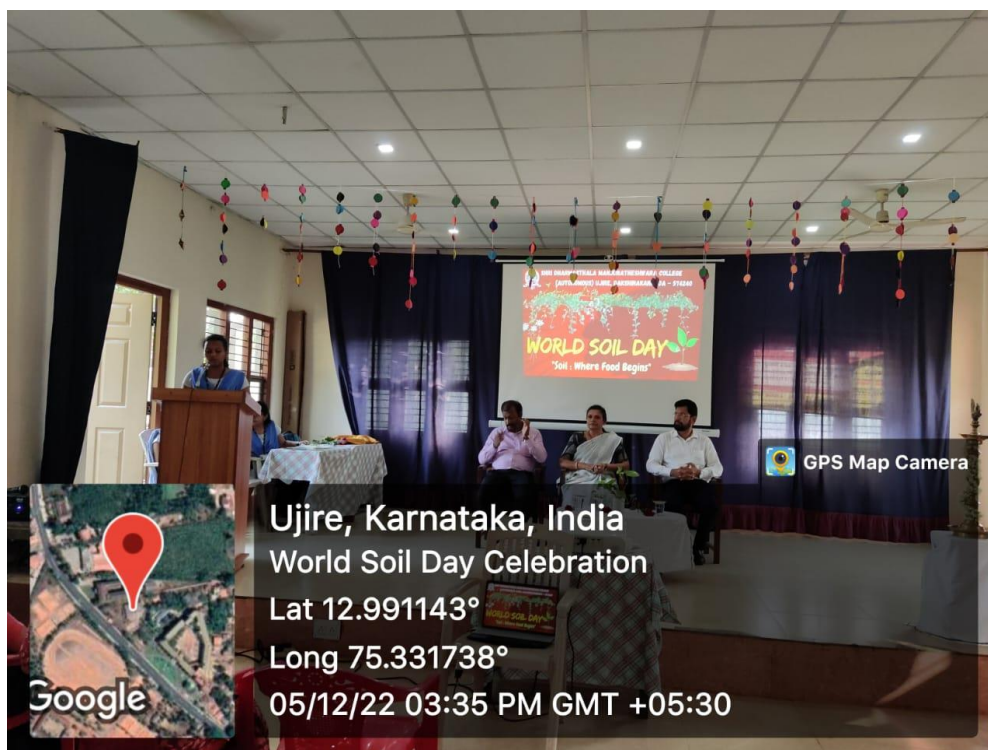






### **World Soil Day**

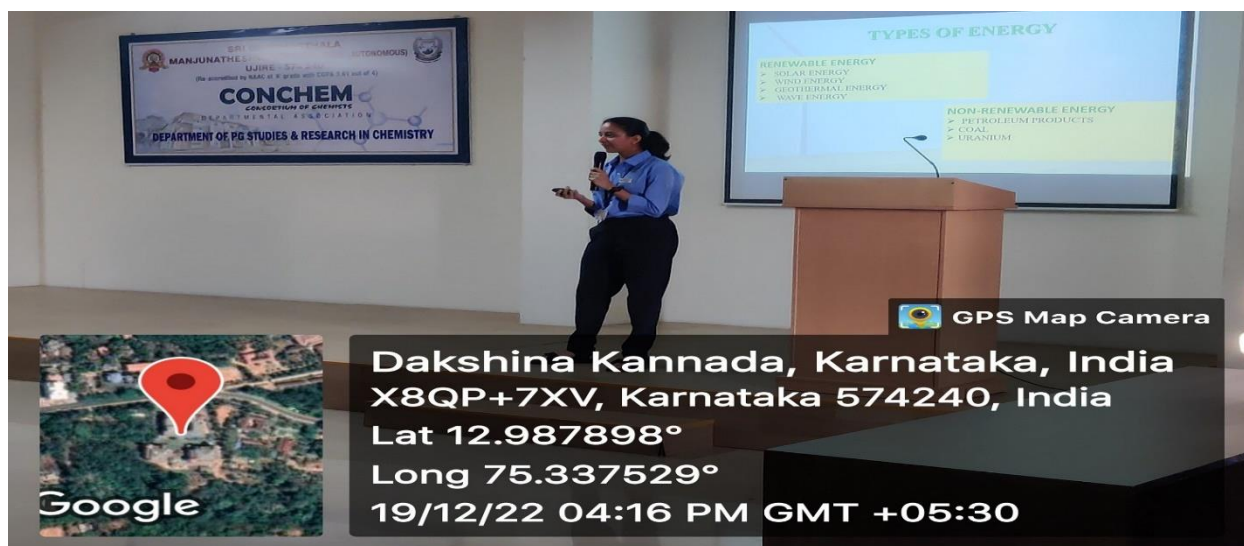






### **National Energy Conservation Day**
