Agenda 1

SDMCU/ UG ENG / BOS/2023- 24/ 02/ 01

Reading the minutes of the previous meeting and action taken report

The chairperson briefed the minutes of the previous meeting held on 18th August 2023 immediately after reading the celebrity of 5th semester from university and action taken report.

It was discussed about the third year BA optional English syllabus for 5th and 6th semester.

- (a) It was decided to check thoroughly the content of the syllabi and units with the distribution of hours for each unit.
- (b) The external members Dr. Subramanya Sharma suggested about the unequal distribution of topics in the Literary Criticism paper and suggested to add some classical articles like Longinus.
- (c) There was a suggestion by Dr. Avinash to consider the modern criticism form which also has no continuity with the essay prescribed.
- (d) Some topics were suggested to be incorporated in paper- Life Narrations with Indian text.
- (e) There was discussion about the incomplete syllabic structure provided by the university and there was a suggestion to wait for some time.
- (f) The agenda was approved by the members.

Revision and approval of the NEP syllabus.

The chairperson put forward the 6th semester papers. There was discussion about **Paper-12**, Post- Colonial Studies. It was discussed about the topics and distribution. The members

discussed about concepts, essays, and text. There was a suggestion about question pattern that short note questions can be framed from concepts.

ReadingPaper- 13, world literature in translation, there was discussion about Unit- 2 and Unit- 4 as there are two novels and two dramas in each unit which are a challenge to classroom teaching with the limited periods in semester calendar. There was a suggestion about taking one text in detail and another as a self-study text.

Paper- 14, women's writing was discussed. It was observed that some text in Unit- 1 resemble the text of 'Gender Studies' paper of 4th semester. However, there was a suggestion that university prescribed syllabus need not be changed in the beginning of introduction. Hence, it was agreed to retain them for the time being. The syllabus of 6 semester was approved.

- 1. **Issues of Gender Equity**: Paper- 14: Women's Writing is completely designed for the discussion of genders, women rights, and feminism. Writings from C. K Janu, Virginia Woolf, Alice Walker are related to gender issues.
- 2. **Human Values and Environment:** the works of Akkamahadevi, Amrita Pritam, Suniti Nam Joshi are concerned with the human values. Dostovesky's novel and Ibsen's play are intended to deal with the issues of humanity and universal questions of Equality.
- 3. **Local, National, and Global Issues:** The paper 'Post- colonial Studies' deals with the global issue of colonialization, imperialism, marginalized and medium of language etc. it discusses issues like orientalism, race, slavery, discourse, hegemony which are post 1990s issues of literature worldwide.
- 4. **Skill Components:** The World Literature in Translation includes the translated text which gives scope to develop skills in understanding vocabulary of other languages and develops familiarity.
