

Chart 1: Opinion on planning of academic activities




Interpretation:






Chart 4: Opinion on relevance of the course to students future development



Chart 5: Opinion on usage of the course for building interpersonal relationships




Interpretation:

Chart 6: Opinion on course content on ethics and values




Interpretation:

Chart 7: Opinion on relevance of student research projects




Interpretation:






Chart 2: Current Syllabus adequately covers contemporary topics /global issues/emerging global and national trends in management


Chart 3: The specified contact hours stated in syllabus is sufficient to complete the coverage of syllabus as per each course by the teachers


Chart 4: Sufficient reference materials and books are available in the library for the topics mentioned in the syllabus


Chart 5: The evaluation methods mentioned in the syllabus are sufficient for providing proper assessment










Table 2: Syllabus has a good balance between theory and practical aspects

Chart 2: Syllabus has a good balance between theory and practical aspects






Chart 3: Syllabus provides comprehensive knowledge and perspective in the subject area

Chart 4: Books prescribed/ listed as reference materials are appropriate, relevant and updated



Chart 5: Current Syllabus adequately covers contemporary topics /global issues/emerging global and national trends in Mathematics



Chart 6: The specified contact hours stated in syllabus is sufficient to complete the syllabus






Chart 7: Sufficient reference materials and books are available in the library for the topics mentioned in the syllabus

Chart 8: The evaluation methods mentioned in the syllabus are sufficient for providing proper assessment




