

**Chart 1: Opinion on Academics** 





**Chart 2: Opinion on Teaching** 



Chart 3: Opinion on syllabus in comparison to other colleges/universities



Chart 4: Opinion on infrastructure and other facilities



Chart 5: Opinion on academic standards of the evaluation





**Chart 1: Opinion on Academics** 





**Chart 2: Opinion on Teaching** 



Chart 3: Opinion on syllabus in comparison to other colleges/universities



Chart 4: Opinion on infrastructure and other facilities



Chart 5: Opinion on academic standards of the evaluation





**Chart 1: Opinion on Academics** 





**Chart 2: Opinion on Teaching** 



Chart 3: Opinion on syllabus in comparison to other colleges/universities



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Chart 4: Opinion on infrastructure and other facilities



Chart 5: Opinion on academic standards of the evaluation


