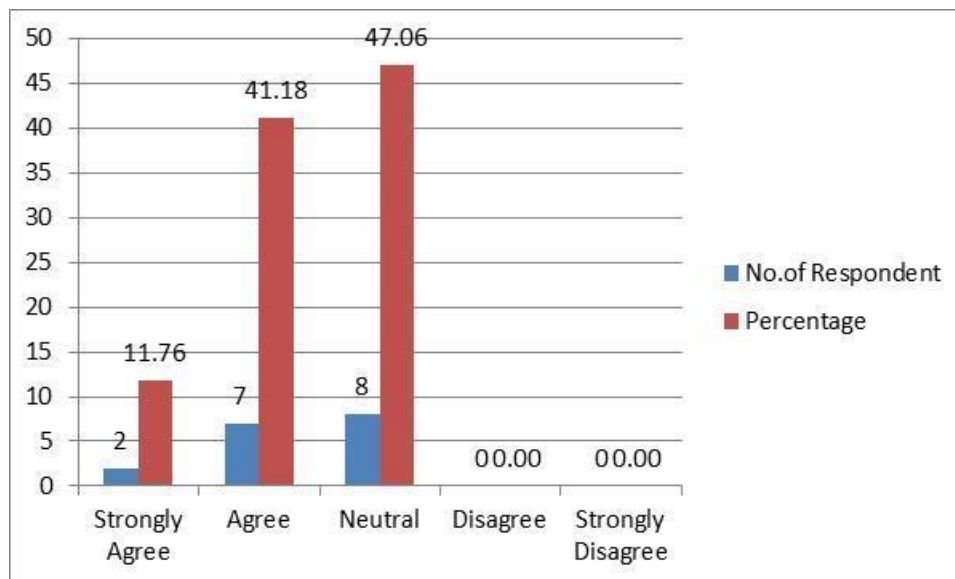

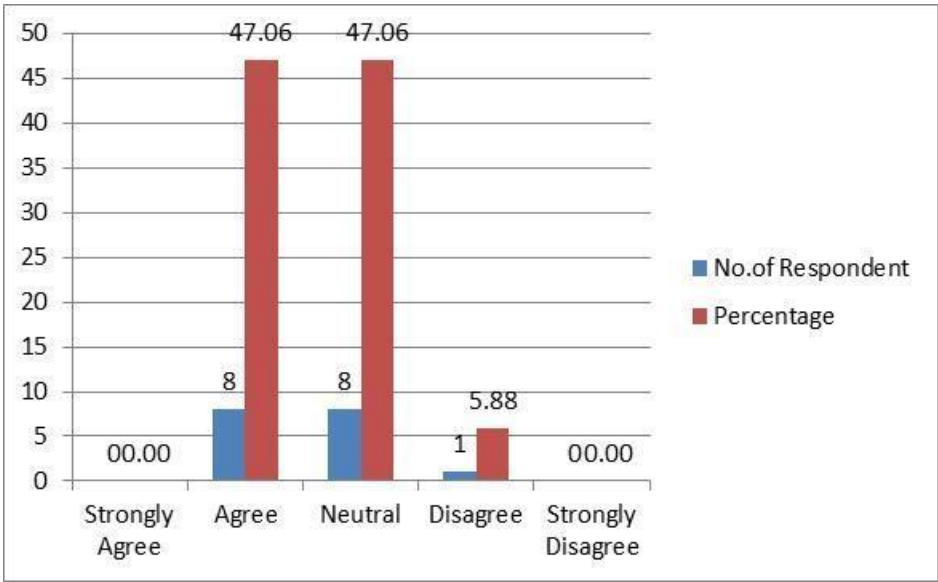

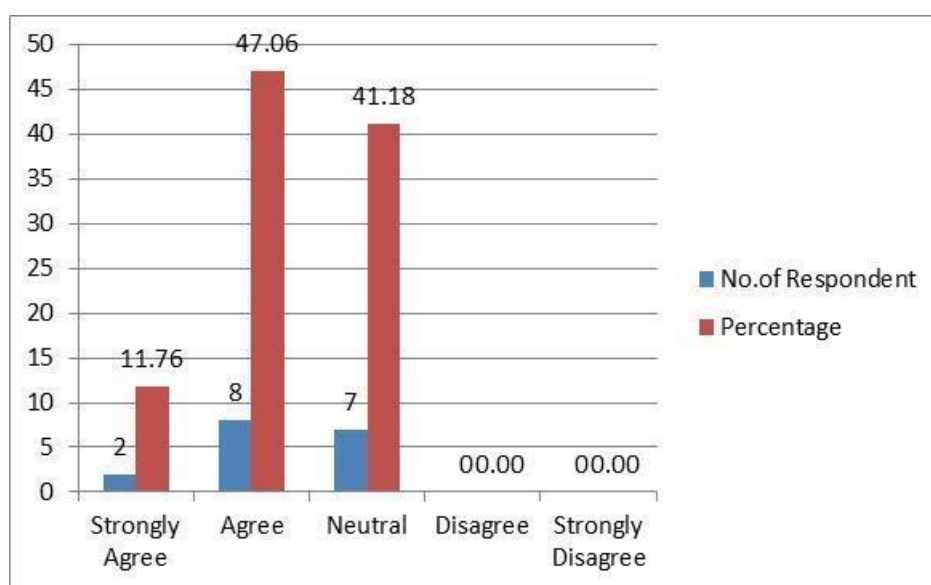

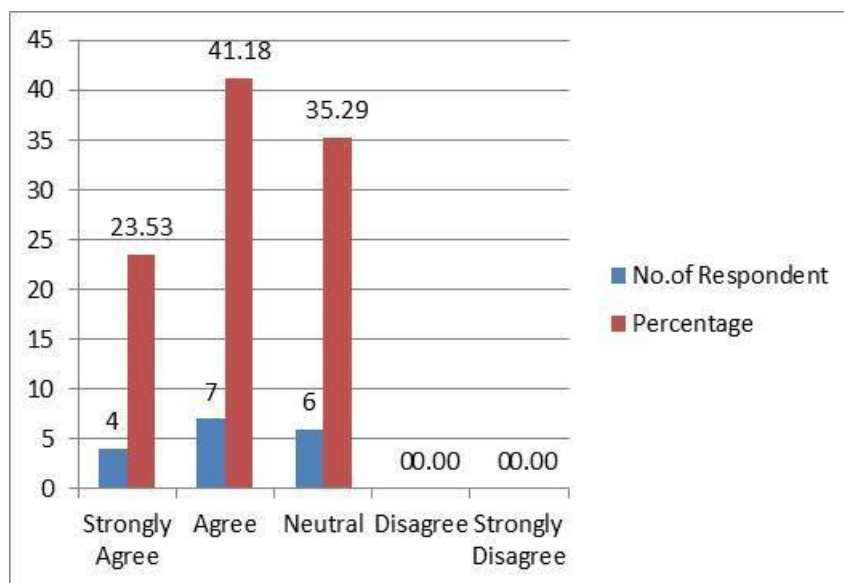

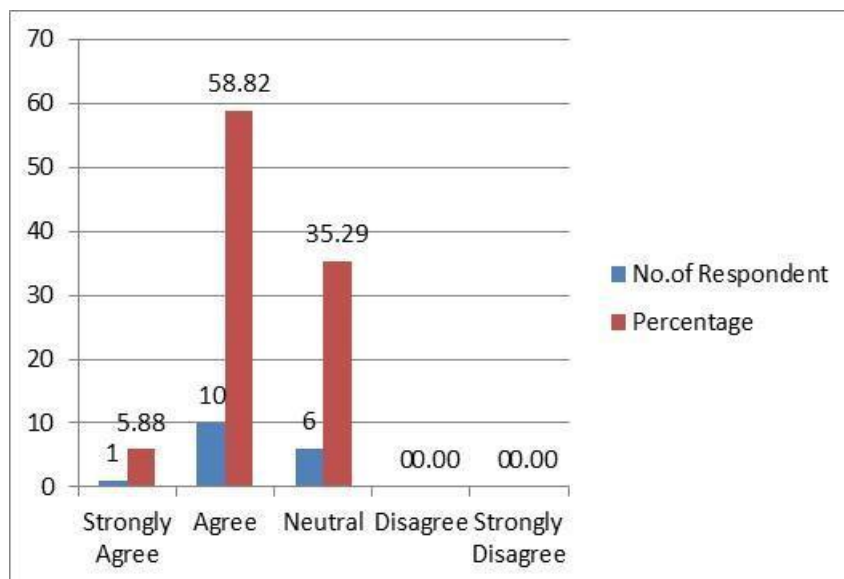

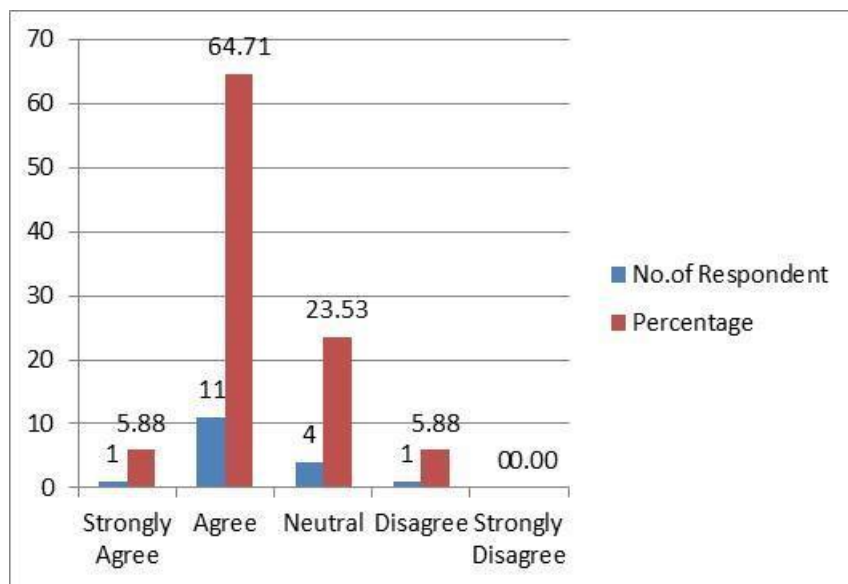

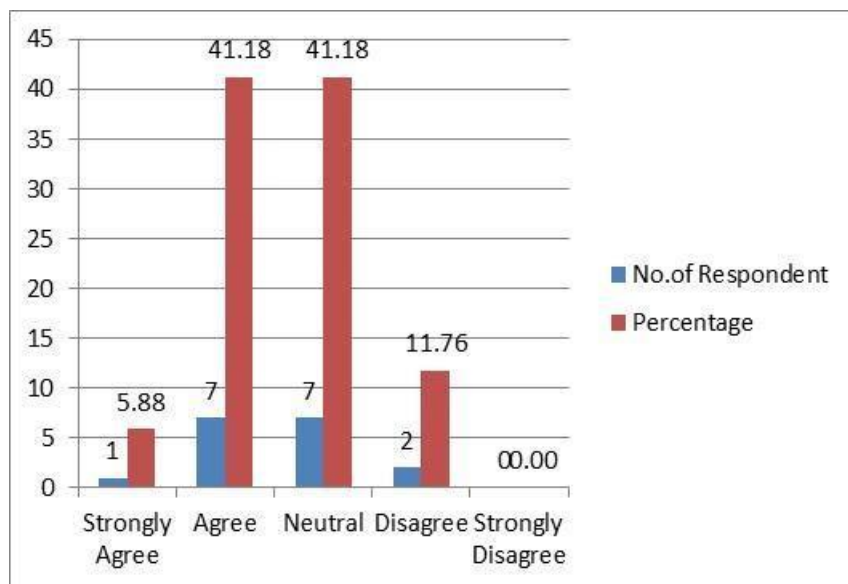

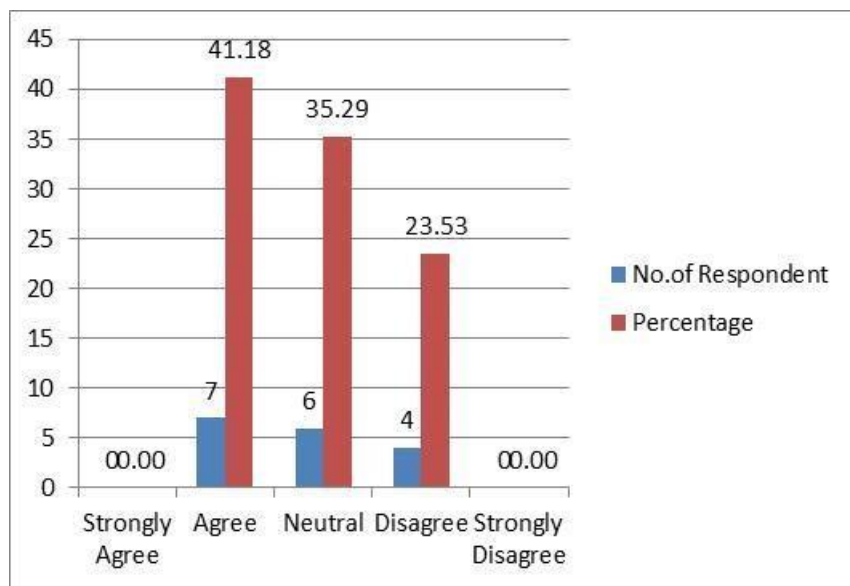

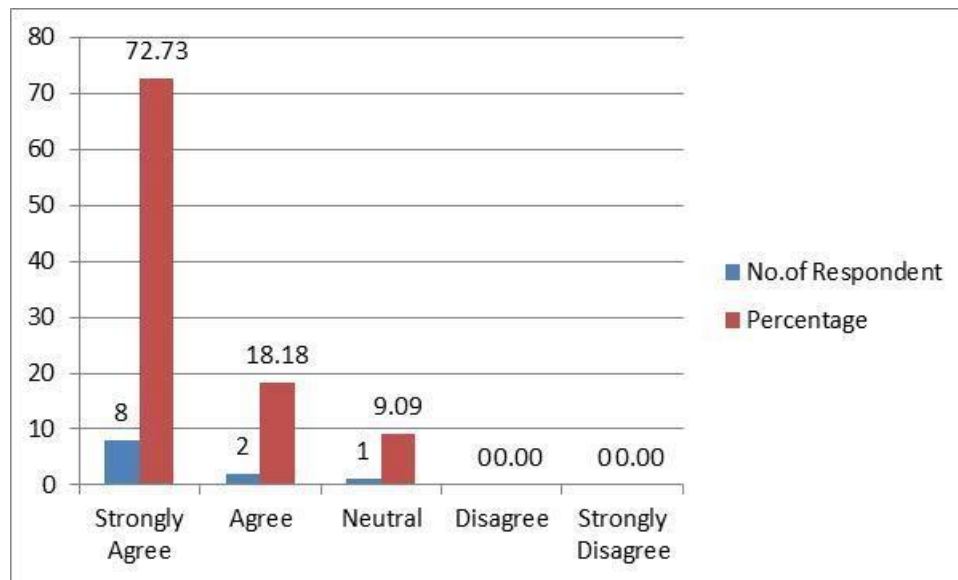

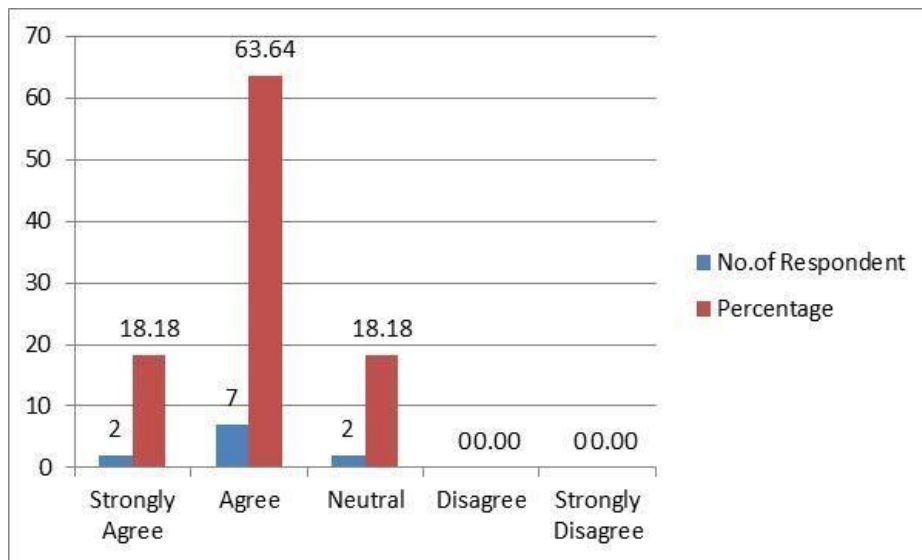

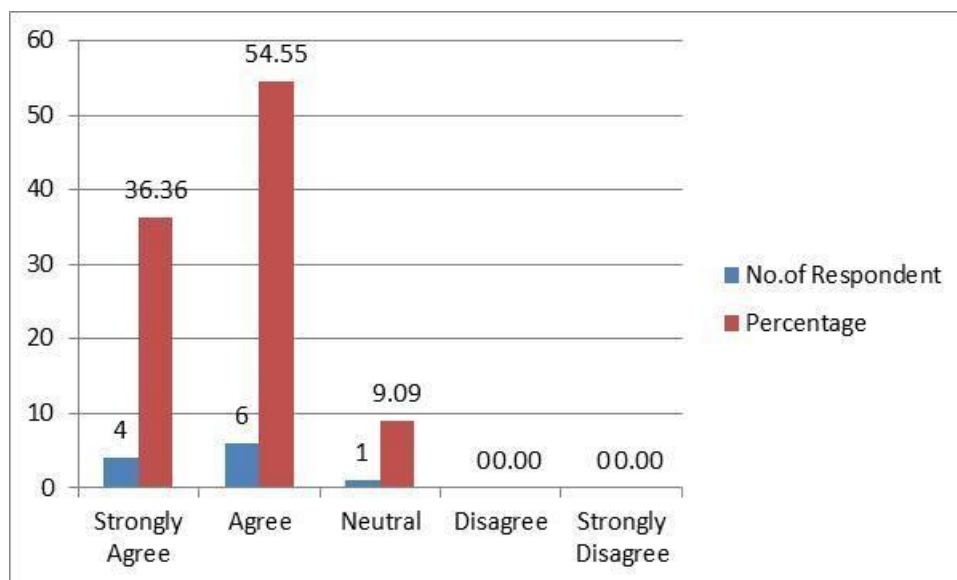

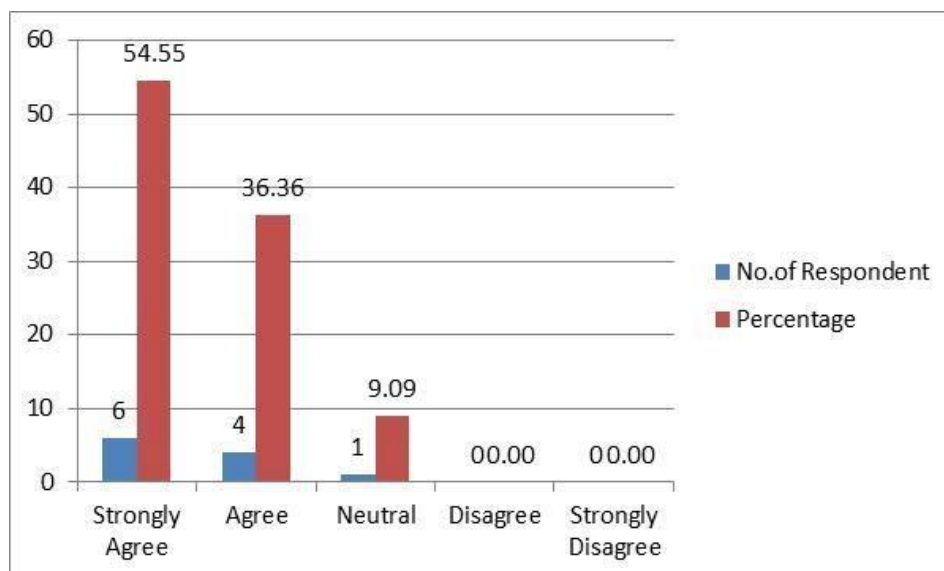

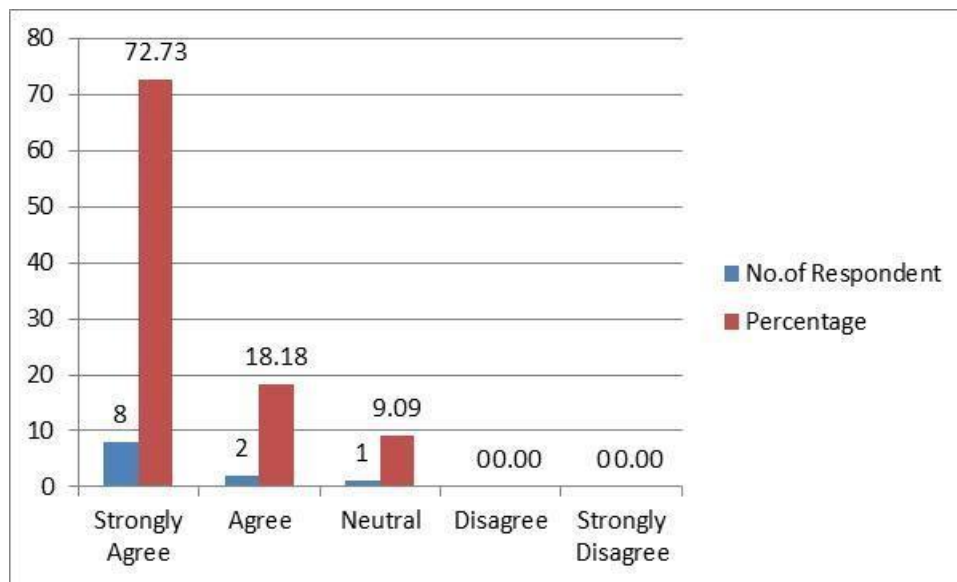

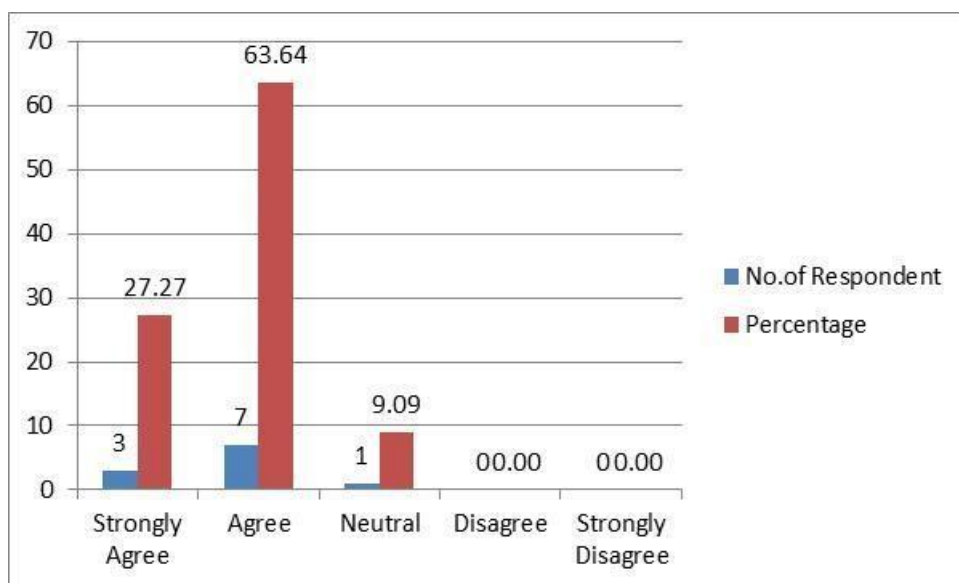

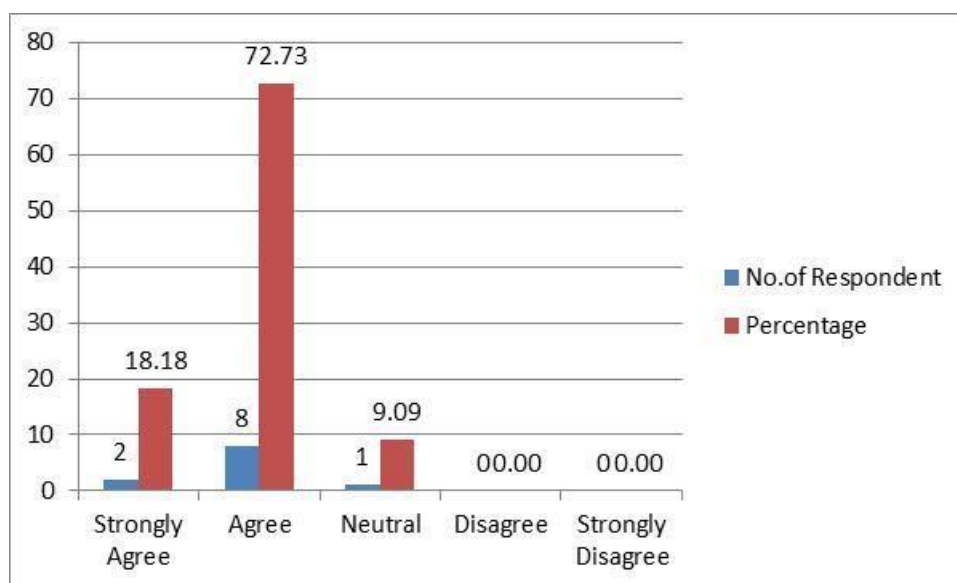

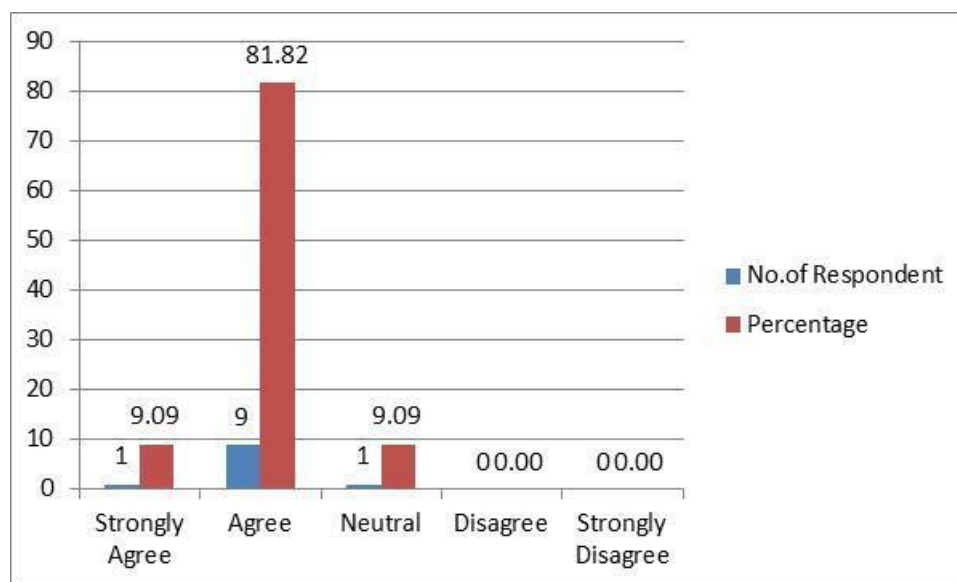

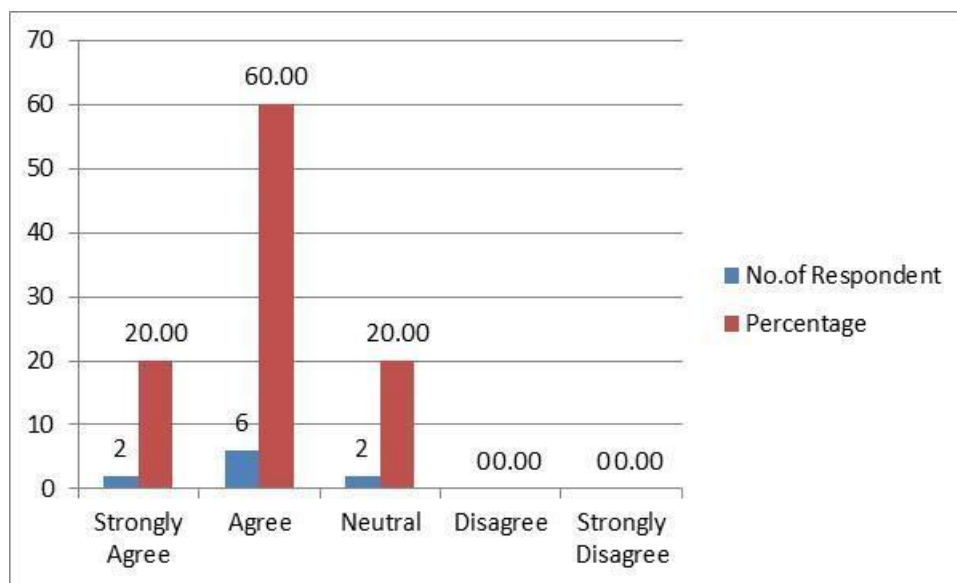

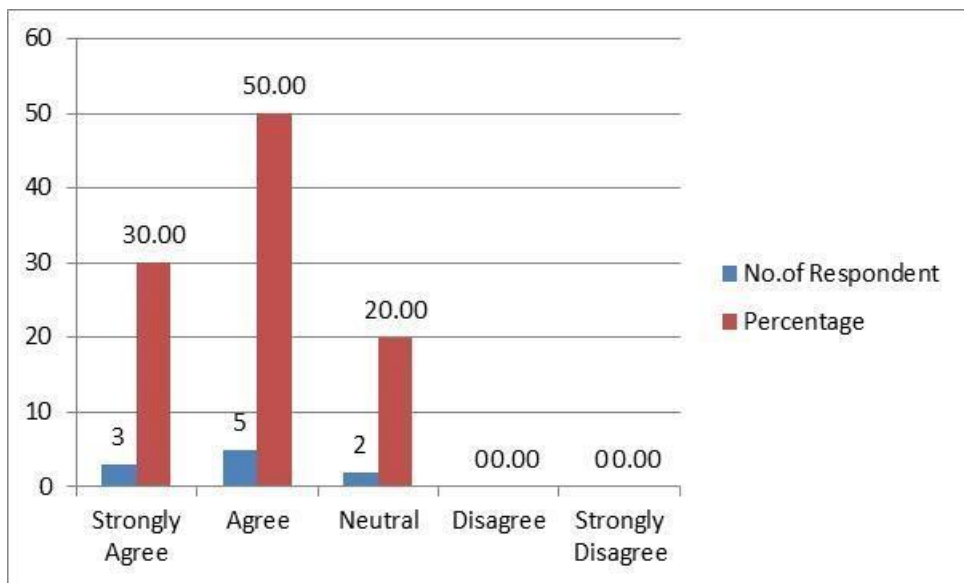

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**Chart 2:** Syllabus has a good balance between theory and practical aspects.

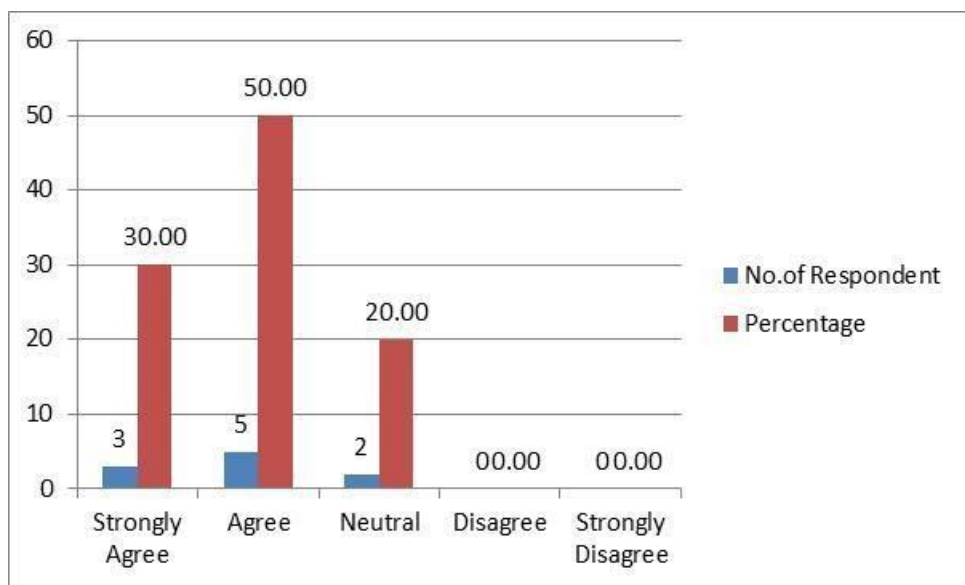

**Chart 3:** Syllabus provides comprehensive knowledge and perspective in the subject area.

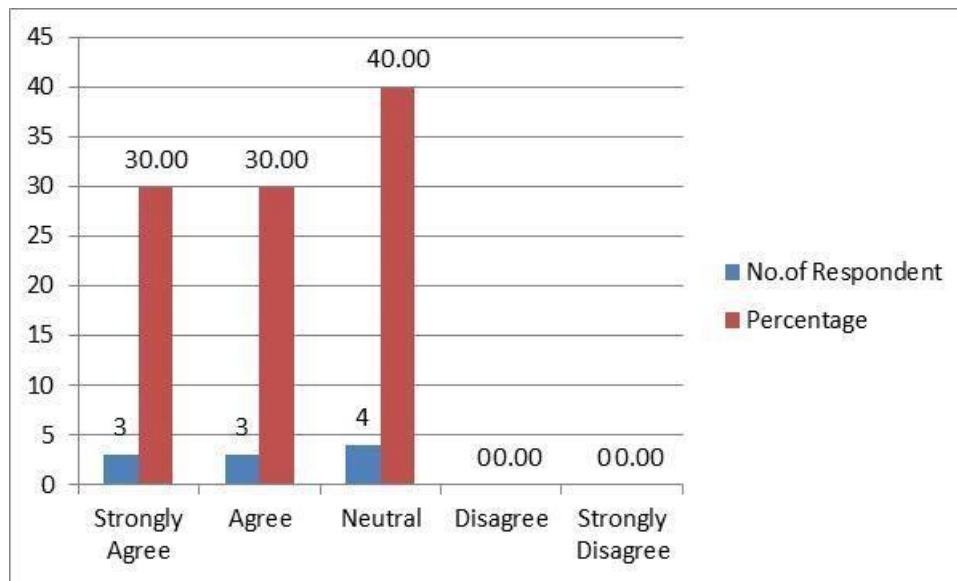

**Chart 4:** Books prescribed/listed as reference materials are appropriate, relevant and updated.

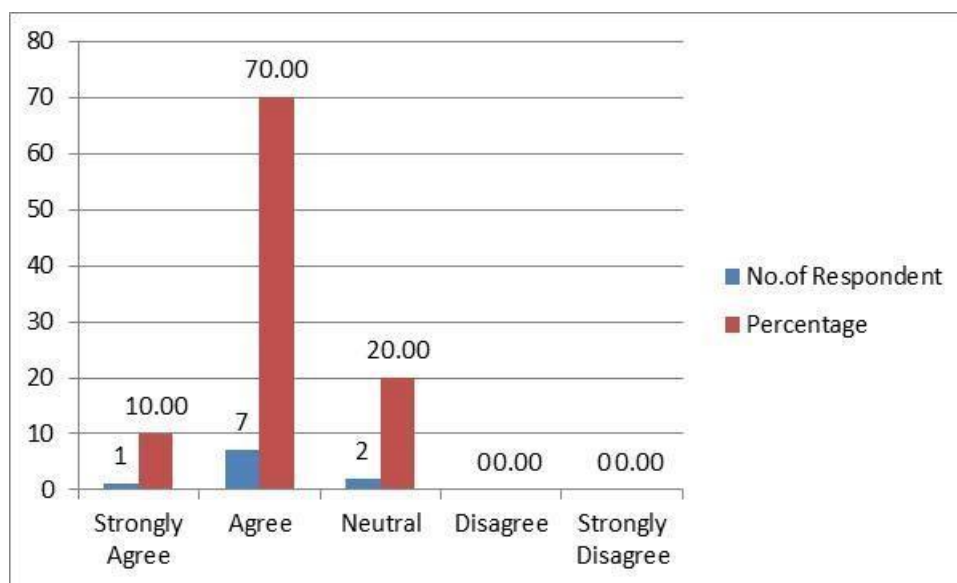

**Chart 5:** Current syllabus adequately covers contemporary topics/global issues/emerging global and national trends in management.

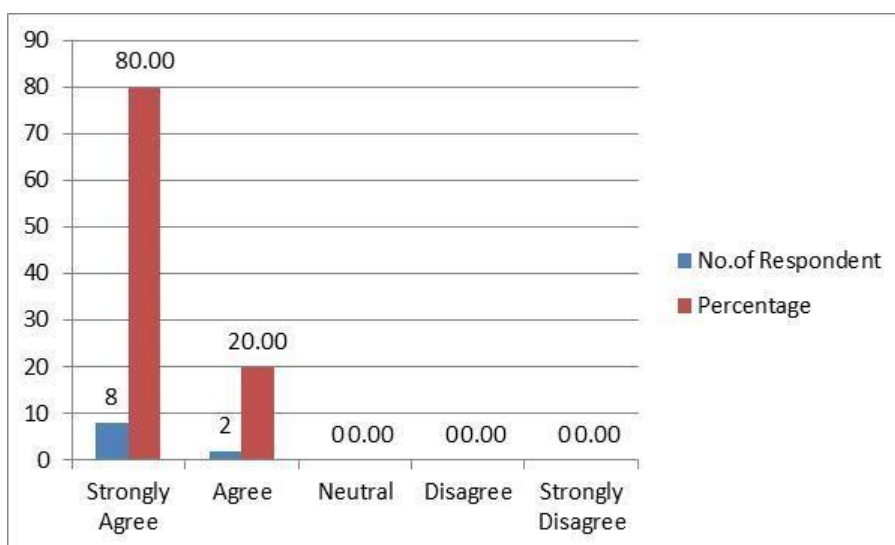

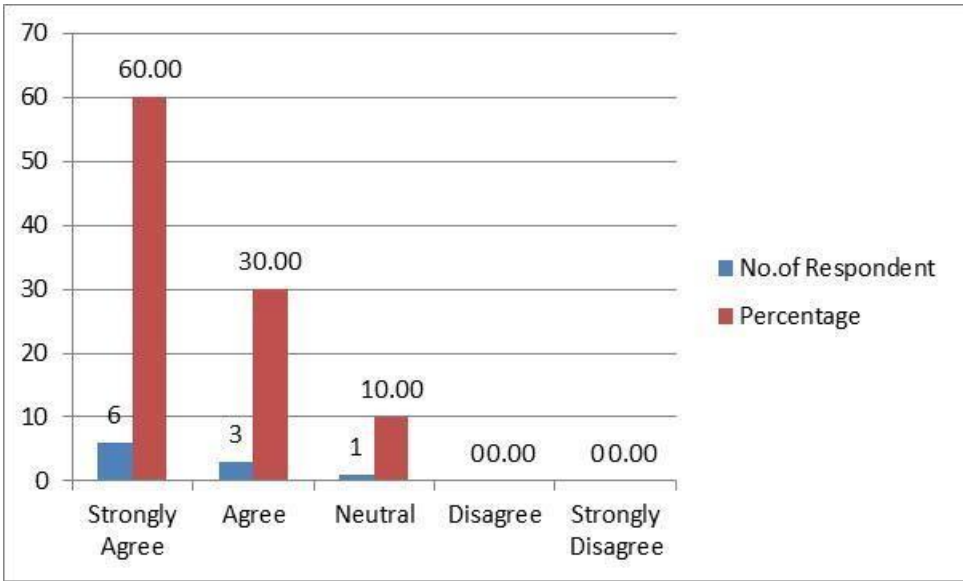

**Chart 7:** Sufficient reference materials and books are available in the library for the topics mentioned in the syllabus.

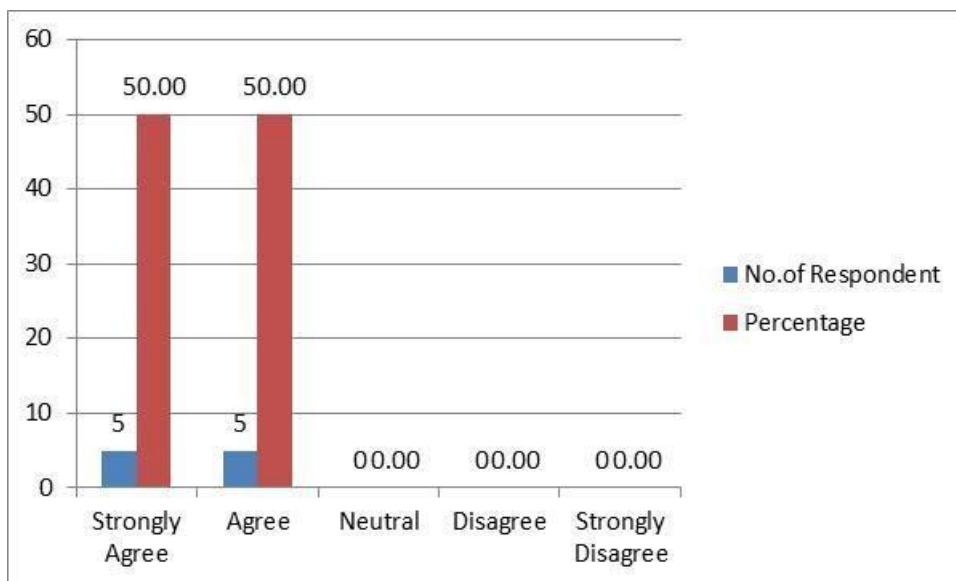

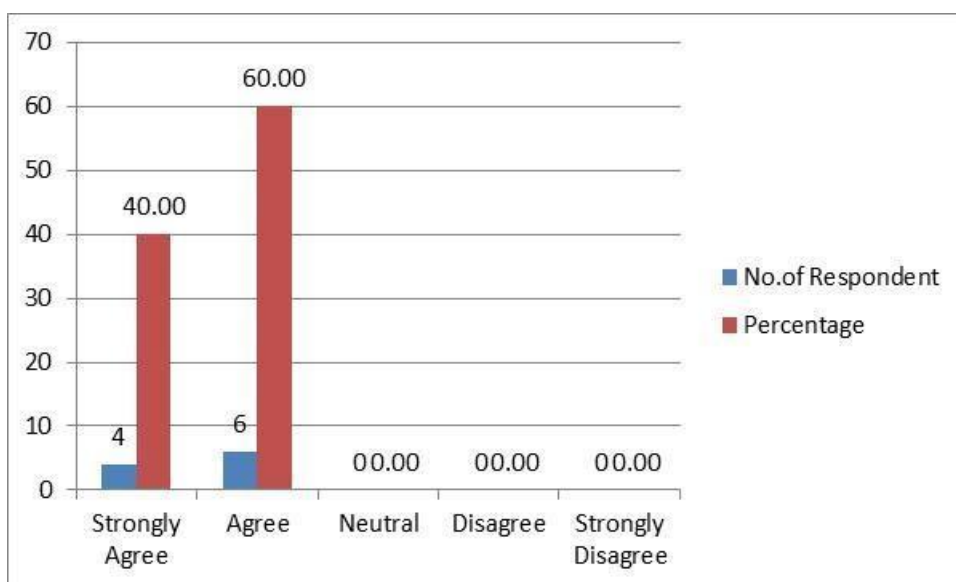
