

Chart 01: The academic plan given in advance helped me to plan my academic activities





Chart -2 : Current Syllabus adequately covers contemporary topics/global issues/emerging global and national trends in management



Chart-3: The specified contact hours stated in syllabus is sufficient to complete the coverage of syllabus as per each course by the teacher



Chart-4 : Sufficient reference materials and book are available in the library for the topics mentioned in the syllabus









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



Chart-2: Current Syllabus is adequately covers contemporary topics/global issues/emerging global and national trends in management















Chart-1: The Contents of the syllabus are relevant to the course.



Chart-2: Syllabus has good balance between theory and practical aspects







Chart-5: Current syllabus adequately covers contemporary topics/ global issues/ emerging global and national trends in mathematics








