













MAJOR FINDINGS

- 1. Based on student input, it is discovered that 80.4% of students concur that the academic plan they were provided assisted them in organizing their academic activities. (Table 1).
- 2. According to student input, 49.0% of students believe that the present syllabus covers modern issues sufficiently. (Table 2)
- 3. According to student comments, 15.7% of students are unsure whether the contact hours listed in the syllabus are enough to cover everything. (Table 3)
- 4. Based on student comments, it is discovered that 29.4% of students concur that the library has an adequate selection of books and reference resources. (Table 4)
- 5. 39.2% of students concur that the assessment techniques included in the curriculum are enough to provide accurate evaluation. (Table 5).
- 6. Based on student input, it is discovered that 52.9% of students concur that the syllabus's contents satisfy expectations in terms of their applicability to real-world scenarios and its practical orientation. (Table 6)
- 7. According to student comments, 74.5% of students concur that the syllabus's contents would be helpful to their future professional growth. (Table 7)
- 8. Based on student comments, it is discovered that 68.6% of students concur that the present syllabus aims to increase employment chances. (Table 8)



Chart 1: Contents of syllabus are relevant to the course





Chart 2: Syllabus has a good balance between theory and practical aspects




Interpretation:

Table 3: Syllabus provides comprehensive knowledge and perspective in the subject area





Chart 4: Books prescribed/ listed as reference materials are appropriate, relevant and updated





Chart 5: Current Syllabus adequately covers contemporary topics /global issues/emerging global and national trends in management




Interpretation:

Chart 6: The specified contact hours stated in syllabus is sufficient to complete the syllabus





Chart 7: Sufficient reference materials and books are available in the library for the topics mentioned in the syllabus




Interpretation:

Chart 8: The evaluation methods mentioned in the syllabus are sufficient for providing proper assessment







Chart 2:Current Syllabus adequately covers contemporary topics/global issues/emerging global and national trends in management.





Chart 3:The specified contact hours stated in syllabus is sufficient to complete the coverage of syllabus as per each course by the teachers.





Chart 4: Sufficient reference materials and books are available in the library for the topics mentioned in the syllabus





Chart 5: The evaluation methods mentioned in the syllabus are sufficient for providing proper assessment.











Chart 1: Current curriculum of B.Voc. programme is relevant for employability





Chart 2: Curriculum caters the needs of industry and meets the expectations of industry





Chart 3: Current curriculum is updated and enhanced the students in terms of knowledge, skills, attitude and innovation





Chart 4: The curriculum has enrichment content which is required for human resource development





Chart 5: Curriculum helps in building entrepreneurial motives which help to the students for starting their own ventures




