Book Review on Local self-Government in Mediaval karnataka

Introduction: "The book local self-government means that residents in towns, villages, and rural settlements are the hosts in thier heads authorising them to solve the most important issues.

**Review:** karnataka is one of the better developed states in India. Land reforms and other development initiatives and opportunities aimed at backward classes and dalits in the 1980s created a society that is not as polarised as in some of the other states in india. This has led to the formation of fairly cohesive society (Manor 1997). A less well known fact about karnataka relates to its long experimentation with decentralisation. Attempts to devolve powers to local bodies had been initiated even before independence. A serious effort to decentralise political structures in karnataka came about in the 1980s. The first major landmark in karnataka was the 1983 Act, which introduced a two-tier, elected sub-state level governance structure. A notable feature was 25 percent reservation for women in these bodies even before this was mandated by the Constitution. Elections under this Act were held in 1987. The 1983 Act was substituted by a new law in 1993 (karnataka panchayat Raj Act, 1993) to accommodate the mandatory provisions brought in the 73rd and 74th amendments to the Constitution. The 1993 Act provides for a three-tier stucture zilla panchayat (districts level), taluk panchayat (block level) and grama panchayat (village level).

**Conclusion:** The panchayati Raj in India is a system established from the time immemorial, From the above research we see that the traces of the panchayati Raj found in the Ramayana Mahabharatha period. We also see from the chanakya Arthasastra which mention about local self-government and its fuctions.

Day one, the visit was to the Department of Chemistry, IIT Madras, located, amidst the lush green campus. The department is powered with many efficient and advanced instruments. The total classes of 71 students along with 5 Staff members were split into 4 groups for the convenient visit to the laboratories. The PXRD is a powerful instrument used to determine the structure of the compound sussing x-rays and the SEM lab where the instrument is used to determine the morphology of the grown nanotubes using high energy electron beam. This laboratory also consisted of the maldi-mass spectrometer used for the characterisation of large biomolecules .The physical lab included TGA, DSC, Physisorption and chemisorption instruments. The TGA and DSC use temperature to determine the physical properties of the sample while the physisorption and chemisorption is used to determine the surface area. The NMR laboratory, located opposite to the PXRD lab, was introduced by Mr.Prabhu, Ph.D. scholar, at the Department of Chemistry, IIT Madras. This instrument has wide applications. The resolution of the instrument was of 500 MHz. Aftera small refreshment break we visited the HPLC, Polarimeter, GC-MS labs. These instruments are mainly used for purity determination. Further we moved onto the UV and FTIR laboratory where both solid and liquid samples could be analysed. This laboratory also contained hydraulic pressure, ATR, fluorimeter and calorimeter. Dr. Mangalasundar Krishnan, Emeritus Professor ex-director of NPTEL and former HOD of the Department addressed the students. He guided us through the various opportunities as chemists at the IITs and other fields. Dr. Nefisath P extended a heartfelt gratitude to the organisers and Dr. Bhaskar and Mr. Elias at the IIT Madras on behalf of Department of PG Studies


