- The systemic changes required to accommodate the undergraduate degree of either 3 or 4-year duration, with multiple exit options within this period and with appropriate certifications such as, a certificate after completing 1 year in a discipline or field including vocational and professional areas, or a diploma after 2 years of study, or a Bachelor's degree after a 3-year programme and finally the 4-year multidisciplinary Bachelor's programme,
- Under NEP 2020, there will be no rigid separations between arts and sciences, between curricular and extra-curricular activities, between vocational and academic streams. This provides students increased flexibility and choice of subjects to study. It needs large scale curricular and organisational restructuring

Of course, there are many more equally significant features in NEP 2020 which need to be adhered to. The task of implementing all these novel features into a realistic academic frame work is extremely challenging and demands long term planning and vision. The future of any academic institution, now solely depends on how well these institutions succeed in implementing the new education policy.

Fortunately, we have been waiting for such a momentous beginning. With the appearance of new sunshine in the form of NEP 2020 and a possibility of raining of new opportunities, it is time to come out and see the Rainbow.

Admissions- 2020

After the announcement of the II PU Public Examination Results on 9 July 2020, SDM College Ujire started admitting students for all the Undergraduate Courses. This year, the aspirants have wide choice of subjects in the courses such as BA, B Com, BSc, BCA, BBA and B Voc. With 11 subjects spread in three groups, the learners can make wide choices while opting for BA Programme. The BSc course is offered with six course combinations. B Com, BBA and BCA are available with specialisation papers.

Since the academic year 2019-20, we started to offer B Voc Courses to the aspirants in Digital Media & Film Making, Software & App Development and Retail & Supply Chain Management. The B Voc Programme is unique in the sense, it offers maximum employability skills to the students. The College also offers 12 Post Graduate programmes in 10 subjects. They are MA in English and Economics, MSW, JMC, M Sc in Chemistry, Organic Chemistry, Physics, Bio Technology, Psychology, and Statistics, M Com General and IBM. Registration for the Postgraduate programmes has already commenced. The aspirant students may visit in person or contact over the phone the college office for the available limited seats.

The admission trend clearly demonstrates great demand for all the courses offered by the college. The college has made every arrangement for the smooth conduct of the admission process by following the guidelines of the Ministry of Health. The Admission Committee of the College deployed thermal scanners and sanitizers at the entrance, marked locations and signboards for the movement of people, bank transaction of the admission fee and online application system.

The college is going to conduct Semester End Examinations to all the final year students and the supplementary examinations for the previous batches of students as per the guidelines issued by the University.

Online Classes

The Campus Audit and Appraisal Committee of the College has conducted a survey on the implementation of the Virtual Classes to the students for the current academic year. Based on the finding the college has decided to extend the Virtual Class facility on a full-fledged mode. The students now attend all the classes of the courses and programmes on a virtual mode. The staff members of the college have recorded more than 1250 lectures for the benefit of the students.
