#### A Webinar Series on Basic Sciences





### Webinar on Nuclear Energy-Boon or Bane to Mankind



UG department of physics and IQAC in association with regional science Centre Pilikula, Mangalore, organized a webinar on the topic Nuclear Energy Boon or Bane to Mankind. Dr. Sripathi Punchithaya, Professor of Physics, National Institute of Engineering (NIE), Mysore, was the resource person.

He explained about basics behind the production of Nuclear energy. 'Nuclear energy is the energy in the core of an atom, where an atom is a tiny particle that constitutes every matter in the universe. Normally, the





mass of an atom is concentrated at the centre of the nucleus. Neutrons and protons are the two subatomic particles that comprehend the nucleus. There is massive amount of energy in bonds that bind atoms together. Nuclear energy is discharged by nuclear reactions either by fission or fusion. In nuclear fusion, atoms combine to form a larger atom. In nuclear fission, the division of atoms takes place to form smaller atoms by releasing energy. Nuclear power plants produce energy using nuclear fission. The sun produces energy using the mechanism of nuclear fusion.' Ms Apeksha Jain, Assistant Professor, dept of Physics mastered the ceremony.




