rebuilding and positive development of the world. Press day is not only a day of celebrating but also it's a day of evaluating the responsibility of journalists.

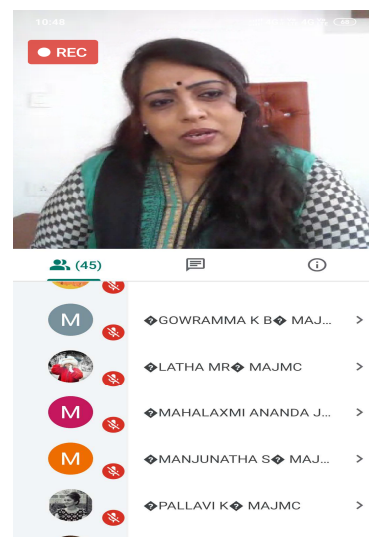

### **Orientation programme on Placement**

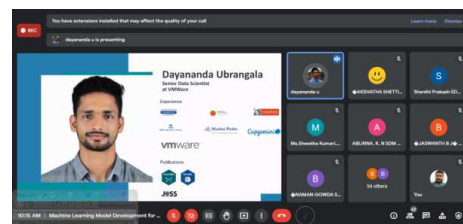

## Student Lecture Series

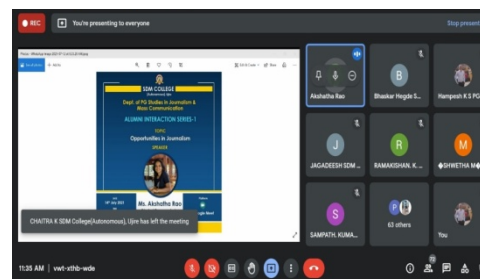
