Essence of Assessment

The models and systems that we develop during the course of an academic exercise needs regular overhaul. It is an essential procedure to keep the system fresh and effective. It is important to understand that the process of system evaluation is not simply about assessing whether an initiative was a success or failure. instead, it is about creating the information and data about the initiative's success and why. Evaluation findings can lead to more effective and efficient program delivery.

In the process of assessment we accumulate and analyse the information on the performance of a policy, program or initiative to make judgments about relevance, progress or success and to inform future programming decisions about design and implementation. Implementation of this policy over time will build a culture of continuous improvement and learning. Hence assessment is one of the most significant exercises in developing a dynamic academic system.

Lack of relevant data can render the evaluation useless. Unless data collection instruments and methods are carefully planned from the beginning of the evaluation period, missing, inconsistent, and untimely data will result in an incomplete evaluation. It also renders the entire procedure ineffective and disoriented. Important parameters like identifying the level of performance and understanding the degree to which goals are attained should necessarily be based on the accurate data maintained systematically at every stage of programme implementation. It also makes the process of assessment a breeze.

The perception regarding the assessment also needs to be developed as an integral part of building a effective system which can truly deliver the desired outcomes and not as a passive mundane procedure. Good yield for a harvest needs fertile soil and timely inputs and assessment is the most significant input to harvest success in academics.
