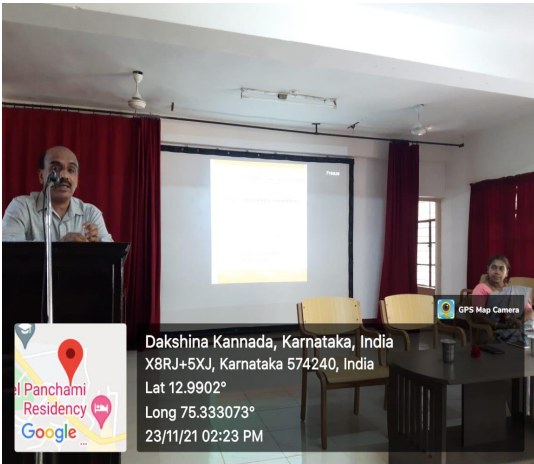


Manager Human Resources, BASF India Limited, Mangalore gave intellect knowledge on “Industrial Relations – The Changing Workforce”.
