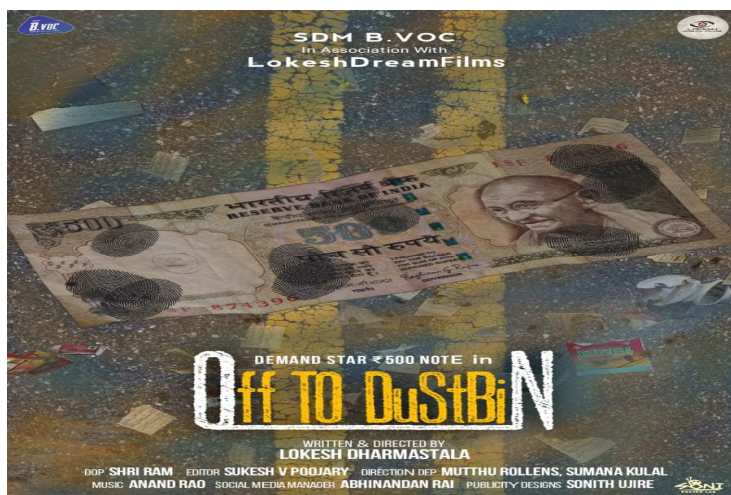
## Lab in Cab
