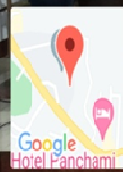

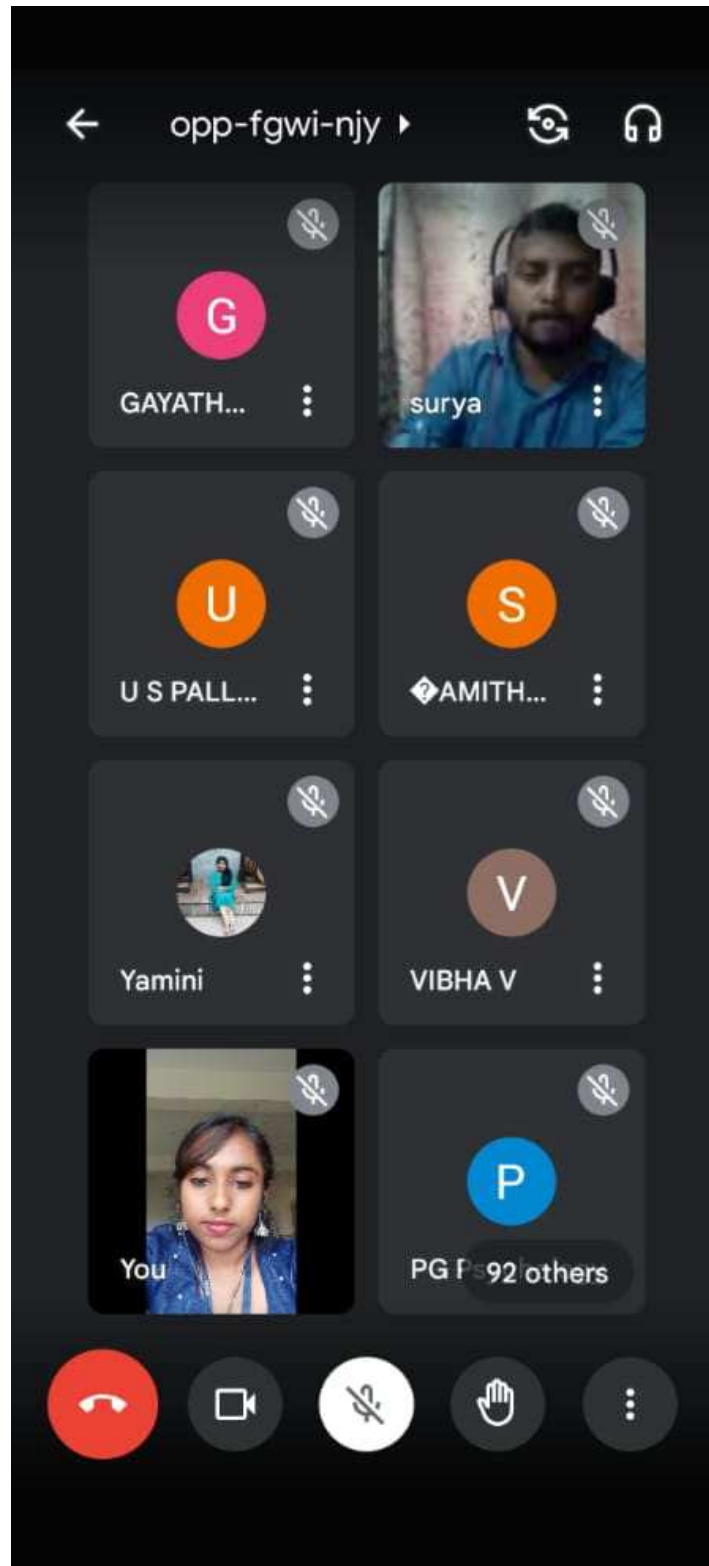
Alumni Interactions
