The College has 5 UG and 12 PG programmes and three Research Centers recognized by Kannada University, Hampi, Mangalore University and Tumkur University. - As a part of individual social responsibility and extension service, the Department of English adopted Government Higher Primary School at Badanaje The students of the department will visit the school every Thursday and train them in Basic English and Communication Skills, which will in turn help the students to prepare themselves to use English in their everyday communication.

- Nationl Service Scheme in association with KMC, Mangaluru and SDM Hospital, Ujire organized 2 Blood Donation Camp on 3 March and 29 January.
- Conducted 'Social Work Rural Camp' at Higher Primary School, Nelyadka from 3 to 8 April. 'Environmental Awareness and Blood Grouping Camp' was organized by the Eco Club at Government High School, Gerukatte and Government High School, Koranja on 18 August. Students of III B.Sc. Biochemistry performed blood group detection for the students.
- A programme for SHG group about 'Women and Children's Health' was organized by the Deaprtment of MSW at Vishvakarma Hall, Punjalkatte on 19 November.
