## **Annual Report 2020-21**

Sri Dharmasthala Manjunathshwara College (Autonomous), Ujire is a coveted centre of higher learning, strongly moored to its motto *Samyak Dharshana Jnana Charithrani*. It is one of the 56 educational institutions managed by SDM Educational Society, Ujire ®, whose vision is '*Putting Value into Education*' while the institution ensures imparting learner-centered quality education.

Founded in 1966, the college offers Bachelors and Masters Programmes in a serene campus at the foothills of the Western Ghats in Karnataka (India). Managed by SDM Educational Society, it is headed by the visionary, Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade, Dharmadhikari of Shri Kshetra Dharmasthala.

The college is aligned with the inculcation of values and ethos among the learners through various academic and administrative initiatives. Carbon-neutral campus, Energy conservation and alternative uses of energy, Green cover and botanical gardens, Water conservation, Reduction in the use of plastic products, Rain water harvesting, Organic waste management, Use of solar energy are some of the initiatives that have brought visible changes. In addition to these, the college has introduced innovations in curricular and co-curricular activities, social responsibility series, optimum utilization of the library facilities, and promotion of research culture in the campus at various stages.

The college offers 44 under graduate and 12 post graduate degree programmes catering to wide ranging contemporary needs. The institution has been constantly revisiting and updating the curriculum with a view to fulfill the objectives related to national and regional development by taking appropriate initiatives to synchronize the student potential and local needs with competent learning. Curriculum of 21 programmes has been revised during this year.

A total of 30 value added courses are conducted by various departments Value-Added courses focus on skill development and employability of the students while internships, study visits and student research projects provide experiential and active learning. 143 Students have participated in the internship, 161 students in field visits, and 2624 have undertaken research projects.

The total number of students enrolled in the academic year 2020-2021 is 3401. There are 140 faculty members, 65 with Ph.D degree . There are 42 administrative staff and 33 support staff who are pivotal in the effective functioning of the institution and instrumental in the success of the institution.

There are 32 departments which actively engaged the learners through academic programmes, interactive, experiential and constructive participatory learning programmes to empower students. These programmes provided a bird's view of the latest developments in the relevant areas.

The college is a recognized center for Ph.D programmes and there are 3 research centers. affiliated to Mangalore University, Tumkur University and Kannada University Hampi. Dr.Ha Ma Na Research Centre is affiliated to Kannada University.
