- > Prof. Sherigar, member, expressed his happiness with regard to implementation of technology and overall progress made by the institution.
- > The members desired that the institution be recognized as degree awarding institution (University).
- > Prof. Sherigar, member, suggested to hold a workshop on preparing research projects for funding from various funding agencies and also to include R & D scientists, Industry Managerial staff in curricular designing as invitees for the BOS meeting.
- > Prof. Pattabi, member, suggested that Dr. K A Suresh, former Director of Centre for Nano and Soft Matter Sciences (CeNS), and an Adjunct Professor at Mangalore University, who has a lot of experience with funding agencies be invited for the workshop.
- > President enquired about the orientation programme being organized to newly inducted staff and suggested to strengthen it.
- > President expressed his concern for the lack awareness among the students and staff on the current affairs at regional, state and national level and suggested that the steps be initiated to inculcate the habit of reading newspapers and teachers be advised to spare some time to discuss the same with the students.
- > Dr. P. N. Udayachandra, Registrar volunteered to take the responsibility of institutionalizing this good practice and maintaining appropriate record for the same to be presented in the next meeting.
