named Thejas and Anvith of 9th Standard, submitted the project titled “A Conceptual study on recent Trends in banking sector in India”.



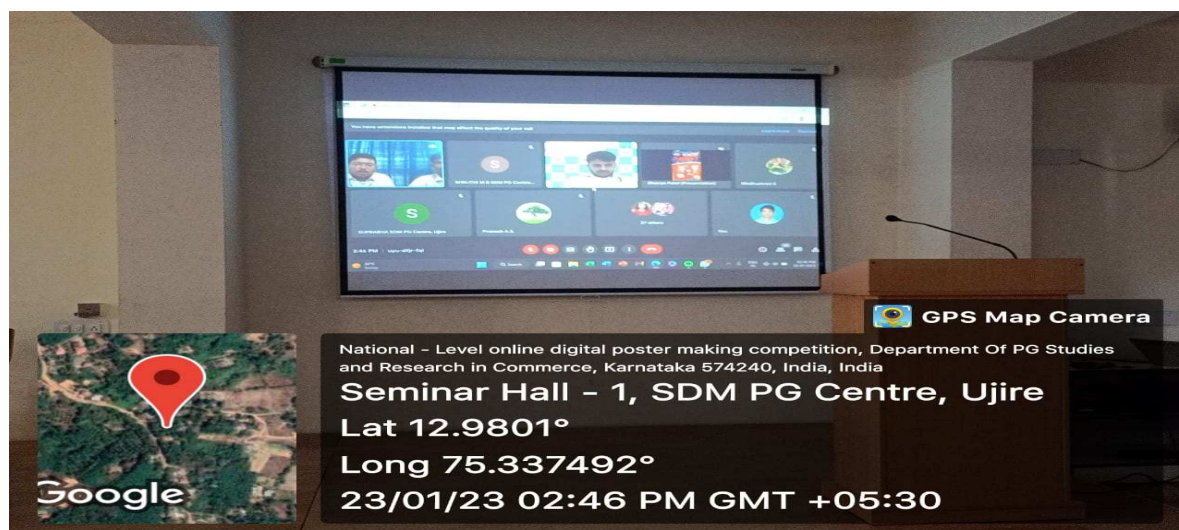

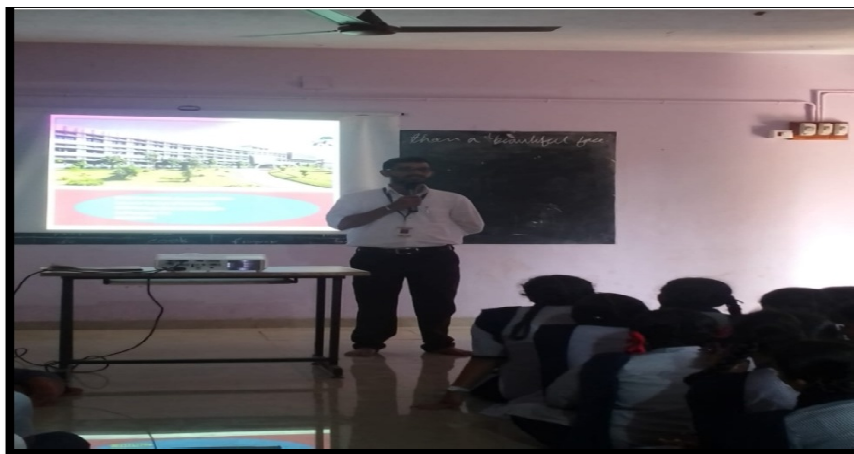
