Field Visits

- The Department of Journalism and Mass Communication and Vijayavani organised a one-day The Department of PG Studies and Research in Chemistry organised an industry-institutional visit to the Department of Chemistry, IIT Madras a reputed national institute in India- and Solara Active Pharma Sciences- an API production industry, Chennai, Tamil Nadu. On day one, the visit was to the Department of Chemistry, IIT Madras, located amidst the lush green campus. The department is powered by many efficient and advanced instruments. The total classes of 71 students and 5 Staff members were split into four groups for the convenient visit to the laboratories. The second day began with a visit to Solara Active Pharma Sciences, a prominent chemical industry. Mr Daniel, HR, and Solara introduced the industry. Mr Suresh Babu, EHS Head, touched on the need for safety and the measures to be followed during work. The session was continued by Dr Rajesh Vyas, an eminent person who elaborated on the scope of chemistry and career opportunities. He also explained the toxicity, placebo effect, and drug discovery, and the session ended with a small discussion. Another session was addressed by Mr Karthik, who gave a brief description of the API industry and an introduction to the pharma industry. On day three, the historic place of Mahabaliouram was explored.


