


• The students of III BA conducted an extension activity on the topic 'Water conservation and Waste Management' for the students of SDM High School, Belal, on 17 February 2024.

- NSS units organised a campus cleaning activity on 23 February 2024. Volunteers collected plastic from in and around the campus. A total of 30 volunteers were present.















