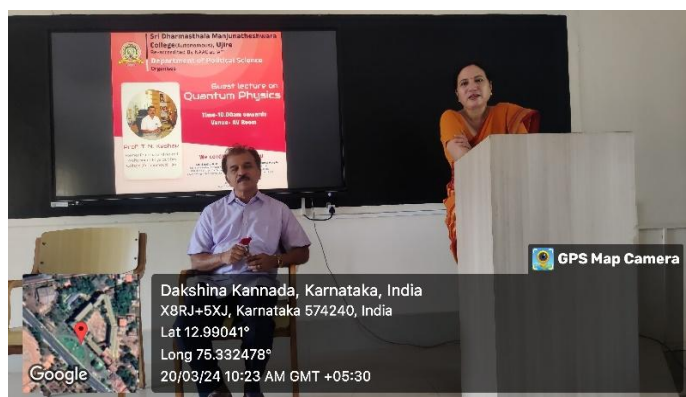
Social Responsibility Initiatives Committee
