ITEM – 1

Placing the minutes of the previous Academic Council meeting and Action Taken Report. (23-03-2024)

The Chairperson presented the minutes of 20th Academic Council meeting held on 23rd March 2024 and action taken report regarding the suggestions made by the honourable members. Members noted the minutes of the meeting and action taken report.

REPORTING ITEMS

Presentation of the brief report of achievements of the college from March 2024 to August 2024.

The chairperson presented the brief report of activities of the college from March to August 2024. Honourable members appreciated the efforts of the institution in conducting Curricular, Co-curricular, Extra-curricular, Extension, Research, Sports and Cultural activities and expressed their happiness for bringing laurels to the College and Mangalore University.

Suggestion by Dr. T. Mallikarjunappa

- To make provisions for B.Voc. students to pursue Master Degree.
- To make it mandatory for students to enroll for Swayam courses on different platforms such as UGC, IGNOU, IIMB etc...
- Additional credit earned by students should be reflected in their marks card or arrangements to be made to issue separate certificate.

Suggestion by Dr. Udaya Kumar

- Students should be compelled to take up short term courses that provide valuable exposure.

Suggestion by Prof. Anitha Ravishankar

- To advertise across the country the great work done by the Digital Media and Film Making department to improve the admission to that programme.

ITEM – 2

Approval of the proceedings of the BOS meetings of UG (Syllabus framed on the basis of S.E.P Structure) and PG departments held from 27th August to 9th September 2024 and Approval for the changes made in the syllabus.

The chairpersons presented the proceedings of the BOS meetings of their respective departments and sought approval for the changes incorporated.

Members resolved to approve the minutes of the Board of Studies.

ITEM – 3

Approval for rotational allocation of Constitution Values paper and Environmental Science paper across first and second Semester.

The Chairperson briefed the members regarding challenges of introducing the current structure, which mandates constitution studies as a compulsory paper for the first semester and Environmental Studies for the second semester. If swapping these subjects between semester is not permitted, the rigid scheduling creates difficulty in balancing the workload of the teachers, managing time table efficiently and optimizing infrastructure usage. Allowing flexibility in scheduling across both semester in our autonomous college could alleviate these issues promoting a smooth academic experience for both faculty and students, as it was done for the last 20 years.

The item was approved with a suggestion to inform the university authority.

ITEM – 4

Approval of new UG Programme in Artificial intelligence and Machine learning to be introduced in the department of Computer Science.

Mr. Shailesh Kumar, HoD of Computer Science briefed the members about the Artificial intelligence and Machine learning programme to be introduced in the department from next academic year and sought the approval of the Council.

Approval for Regulations Governing the acts of Indiscipline and Malpractice in the Semester Examination

- To form an investors club to educate students on collaborative investment decisions and stock markets.


Suggestion by Prof. Vishalakshi B.
