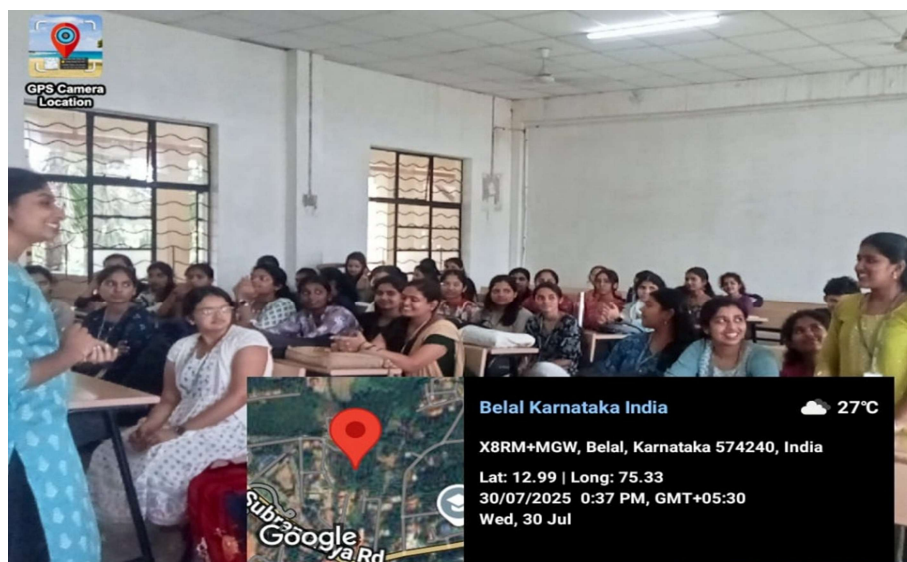
Alumni Interactions
